DAVID HUFFMAN, MY FATHER WAS THE FIRST OF OUR FAMILY IN ALA. MY UNCLE *Alexander* HUFFMAN CAME AFTER HIM IN 1832 AND LIVED IN THE LOWER END OF TUSCALOOSA CO., ADJOINING PICKENS. THESE ARE THE ONLY TWO OF OUR FAMILY WHO EVER LIVED IN ALA. AND LEFT DESCENDANTS IN THIS STATE. MY GRANDFATHER, DANIEL HUFFMAN, OF GERMAN DESCENT, AND MY GRANDMOTHER, HIS WIFE, ELIZABETH PASTON, OF IRISH DECENT, BOTH OF WHOM LIVED AND DIED IN FAIRFAX DIST. S.C. ABOUT 12 MILES FROM *WINESBORO* HE WAS A FARMER. I DONT KNOW WHEN THE ANCESTORS OF EITHER CAME TO AMERICA, NOR ANY OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES. IT IS RECOLLECTED IN OUR FAMILY THAT MY GRANDFATHER WAS ONE OF 8 BROTHERS WHO SCATTERED ALL OVER THE STATES AND WHO HAVE LEFT DESCENDANTS OF THE SAME. MY IMPRESSION IS THAT THEIR ANCESTORS NEVER CAME TO AMERICA OR DIED SOON AFTERWARDS.

ELIZABETH HUFFMAN MARRIED ^{JAMES} JOINER CORK IN FAIRFIELD DIST S.C. THEY MOVED IN THE 30'S TO CHOCTAW OR CHICKASAW CO MISS. I THINK WHERE THEY DIED LEAVING ONE DAUGHTER, WHO MARRIED THE COUSIN MR. CORK.

5 *Mary*.....HUFFMAN WHOSE NAME I DONT REMEMBER, MARRIED *JOHN CORK* A BROTHER OF JAMES CORK. SHE LIVED AND DIED IN S.C. I THINK HER NAME WAS MARY OR MOLLY AND HER HUSBAND WAS JNO CORK. THEY LEFT DESCENDANTS.
