DAVID HUFFMAN, MY FATHER WAS THE FIRST OF OUR FAMILY IN ALA. & UNCLE ~~Alexander~~ HUFFMAN CAME AFTER HIM IN 1832 AND LIVED IN THE LOWER END OF TUSCALOOSA CO., ADJOINING PICKENS. THESE ARE THE ONLY TWO OF OUR FAMILY WHO EVER LIVED IN ALA. AND LEFT DESCENDANTS IN THIS STATE. MY GRANDFATHER, DANIEL HUFFMAN, OF GERMAN DESCENT, AND MY GRANDMOTHER, HIS WIFE, ELIZABETH PASTON, OF IRISH DECENT, BOTH OF WHOM LIVED AND DIED IN FAIRFAX DIST. S.C. ABOUT 12 MILES FROM WINEFORD. HE WAS A FARMER. I DONT KNOW WHEN THE ANCESTORS OF EITHER CAME TO AMERICA, NOR ANY OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES. IT IS RECOLLECTED IN OUR FAMILY THAT MY GRANDFATHER WAS ONE OF 8 BROTHERS WHO SCATTERED ALL OVER THE STATES AND WHO HAVE LEFT DESCENDANTS OF THE SAME. MY IMPRESSION IS THAT THEIR BROTHERS NEVER CAME TO AMERICA OR DIED SOON AFTERWARDS.

 DIED OF..... STEWARD, WHO MOVED AWAY PROBABLY TO PICKENS  
 DAVIS PLACE. HERE HE STOPPED AND BOUGHT OUT THE LAND XXXXX  
 VALLEY HE WENT DOWN IT, UNTIL HE CAME TO THE PRESENT  
 RIVER. THEY WENT ON TO THE LOWER PART OF TUSCALOOSA CO. REACHING  
 STREET CT, CLERK OF 1823-6) WERE THE ONLY OTHERS ACCOMPANYING  
 TWO, AND BENJAMIN AND HER BROTHER JAMES DODDS (PROBABLY THE  
 HEDDING AND HOUSEHOLD SUPPLIES. WIDOW MAYO, HER TWO SONS,  
 CHILDREN, AND HIS WIFE. HE BROUGHT HIS CATTLE,  
 IN A WAGON DRAWN BY 4 HORSES. THE FAMILY CONSISTED  
 ONE AND BUNDLED UP FOR HIM  
 THE LEARNING OF THE COUNTRY AND.....  
 AND THROUGH CA AND PROBABLY.....  
 THE LEARNING WERE ABOUT 1816/1817.....  
 AND HUSBAND BY MARRIAGE.....

JOSEPH ALEXANDER HUBMAN BORN..... MARRIED JEANETTE CAMERON  
 IN TUSCALOOSA CO. MOVED TO TEXAS IN 1851, WHERE THEY DIED
