



How can I use the Card Catalog to find one specific database?

Because of the large number of databases on Ancestry, we do not expect you to simply know where a specific database can be found. To assist you with this, we provide a Card Catalog (and database list) for quickly locating the information you need.

Finding the database list

A list of all of the databases on Ancestry can be found hovering your cursor over the Search button. You will then click on Card Catalog from the dropdown list.



Search Tiffes

The simplest method of finding a particular database is to search for it. Just as our site provides the ability to search for individuals, it also allows you to search for databases. After going to the list of all databases (see above), a search template should appear at the top left corner of the page. Use this as you would a search template elsewhere to search for a database name. If you do not know the name of the database you want, enter words that are likely to be in the title, such as Kentucky, cernetery, or history.


