### How can I use the Card Catalog to find one specific database?

Because of the large number of databases on Ancestry, we do not expect you to simply know where a specific database can be found. To assist you with this, we provide a Card Catalog (and database list) for quickly locating the information you need.

#### Finding the database list

A list of all of the databases on Ancestry can be found hovering your cursor over the Search button. You will then click on Card Catalog from the dropdown list.

### Filter Titles

You can also filter the databases down by the location, the date as well as the language that database is in. You can filter by a single choice or by multiple choices, such as filtering to Census and Voter Lists in the 1850's to narrow down the filter further.

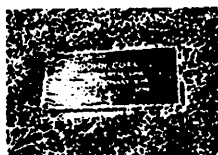

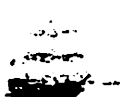
