

Illness Is Fatal To A. P. Corley

The Rev. Angus Patterson Corley died yesterday afternoon at his home, 1005 Beaty's Ford Rd., after a brief illness. Funeral arrange-

ments are incomplete.

A native of White Pond, S. C., he was the son of the late Henry and Lizzie Corley. He was a graduate of old Biddle University (now Johnson C. Smith University), finishing his undergraduate course in 1909 and the school of theology in 1912. He served the college as dean for several years before teaching at Mt. Holly, Newell School and at Rock Hill School in Lincolnton

County.

He held pastorates at New Hope Presbyterian Church in Mecklenburg County and Davidson Presbyterian Church at Davidson for 25 years. At the time of his death he was pastor of Brandon Presbyte-rian Church in Charlotte, which he

rian Church in Charlotte, which he had served for the last 17 years. Survivors include his widow, the former Nannie McCrorey of Fairfield County, S. C.; two sons, William Corley of Washington, D. C., and Angus P. Corley Jr. of White Plains, N. Y.; three sisters, Mrs. Stella Johnson, Mrs. Tona Holland of New York City and Mrs. Sylof New York City and Mrs. Sylvania Moses of Jacksonville, Fla.
