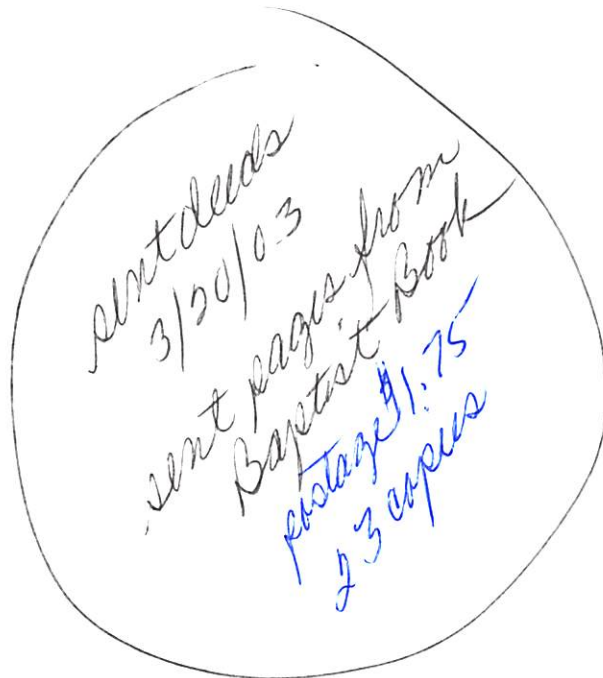
Hello Linda,

Do you know the location of the land that Littleton Crankfield owned? Here is the history that I know about Littleton Crankfield. He married Lucy Wilson. Her father was named James Wilson. James Wilson had given Littleton Crankfield 500 acres of land, and later another 500 acres of land. My ancestor is Eliza Crankfield, the daughter of Littleton and Lucy Crankfield. She married George W. Bush and moved to Kentucky in about 1841. Her brothers were Isaiah, Allen, and Jonathan. Her sisters were Temperance, Margaret Jane, and it is thought she had a sister named Pamela who married a Stokes. That would explain why Littleton in his last will and testament included Pamela's children. Pamela must have already been deceased at the time. In the Key Clue to Uncle Tom's Cabin

written by Harriett Beecher Stowe, Separation of Families, it has a sheriff's sale (Fairfield S.C) where Temperance who married a Miller was suing her brother, Allen R. Crankfield for property.

I plan to visit and would like to find the land that Littleton Crankfield owned. I will be glad to receive the land/deeds records. You are an excellent researcher. Are you a volunteer?

Crankfield at the suit of Alexander Brodie, 2 mules levied upon as the property of Allen R. Crankfield at the suit of Temperance E. Miller and J.W. Miler, 1 pair of Cart Wheels, levied upon as the property of Allen R. Crankfied at the suit of Temperance e. Miller and J.W. Miller, 1 chest of draweres levied upon as the property of Allen R.
