

Know all men by these presents that I Thomas W Crow of the State of South Carolina and District of York for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and thirteen dollars I have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain sell and convey to Joseph Herndon a certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation of 413 acres lying and being in the county and State aforesaid on the long Branch of Buffaloe Creek Beginning at a Stake in place of a Black oad Originally known as Pattersons corner runs west 34 poles to a Stake James Crows corner thenwith his line North 84 poles to a Stake on the spring branch James Crows corner then North 88 East 87. poles to a Black oak thens North 3 W. 137. poles to a Stake thenS. 48 East 107. poles to a fallen pine So. 49 E. 190 to post oak then S.41. w.200 poles to a Stake then N 49 W.38 poles to a fallen Spanish oak thenS. 41. W.154. poles to a small post oak then North 37.W. 100 to a post oak mrs Crows corner then East 84 poles to a white oak thensse North 94. poles to the Beginning Together with all the rights members and appurtenances and I do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the above mentioned premises unto the said Joseph Herndon his heirs and assigns against myself heirs and assigns and against any and every other person whatever claiming this arm (?) or any part thereof In Testimony whereof I hereto set my hand and seal this the 4th day of April 1840 † in the 64th year of our Independence signed Sealed and acknowledged in the presence of witness

 that is to say after the Lord sees proper to call me from
 this world my will is that I be deacently Buried
 my will is also that all my Just debts be paid
 I will and bequath to my beloved wife Hanny Crow
 all the land I now own, also all the personal property
 during hir widowhood to do as she may think proper
 and if she may think proper not to remain a widow
 My will is that she have the loved man ('s) Saddle
