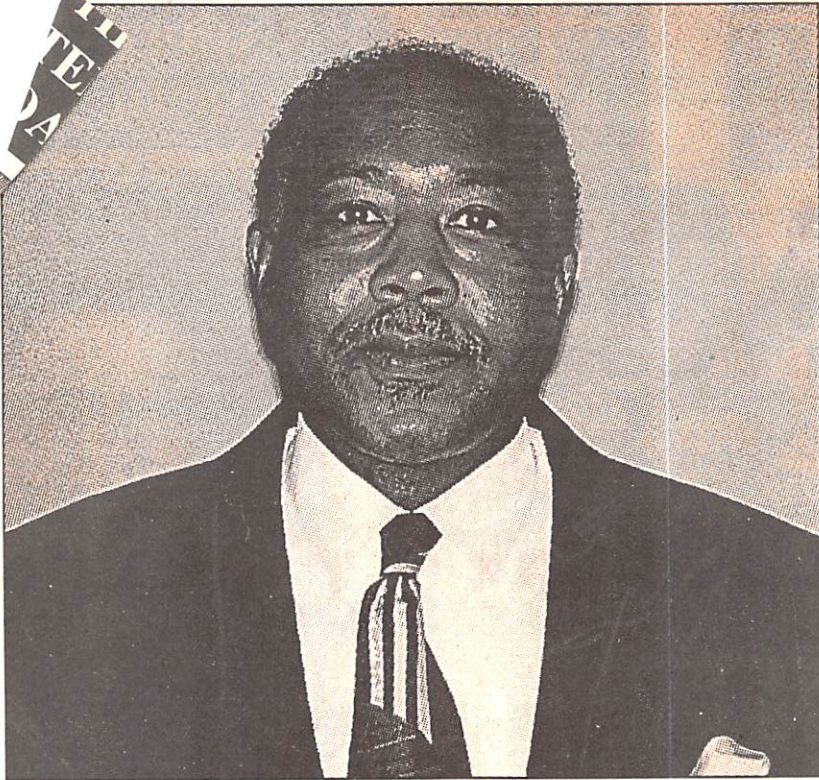

Robert W. Davis is seeking re-election to the Fairfield County Council from District 3.
