Davis competed in the 100 meters and the 4x11 meter relay. After a faulty start, he managed to place 12th out of approximately 64 kids and the relay placed 15th.

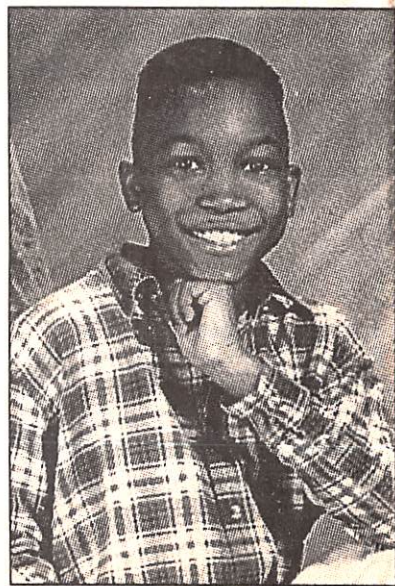
The competition had participants from states as far as
