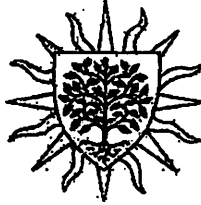

Newspapers

Death notices are from the Fairfield Herald, July 4, 1866 to September 6, 1876, and The News and Herald, October 19, 1876 to February 24, 1916. Both newspapers were published in Winnsboro, South Carolina.
February 14, 1906 Issue

Mr. Charles A. Dickey died at his home in Winnsboro on January 25th at the age of about 65. He was a native of Ireland and leaves a wife, daughters and sons. He was in Co. B, of the 7th S. C. Battalion.

Mrs. Eveline Craig Byrd, widow of **Capt. Downs Byrd**, died on Saturday at the residence of her nephew, **Mr. O. L. Hunter**, at Ora at the age of about 74. She is survived by one daughter; **Mrs. Jas. P. Dillard** of Tylersville, and three sons; **Mr. Thos. P. Byrd** of Ora, **Mr. William D. Byrd** of Tylersville and **Rev. Samuel C. Byrd** of Winnsboro. She was buried at the family graveyard near the old Byrd homestead.

Marriage notices and implied marriages from the Fairfield Herald, August 1, 1866 to October 5, 1876, and The News and Herald, October 12, 1876 to February 24, 1916. Both of these newspapers were published in Winnsboro, South Carolina.

February 14, 1906 Issue

Mrs. Jas. P. Dillard was a **Byrd**, daughter of **Downs** and **Eveline Craig Byrd**.

Mrs. James P. Dillard was from Tylersville (possibly Laurens County, SC), not in Fairfield County.

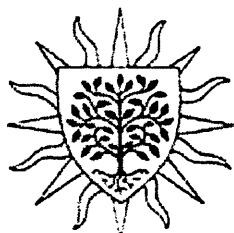
