The James Douglass that I have highlighted is my G.G.G.Grandfather. One of his sons, Robert A. Douglass is my G.G.Grandfather. Roberts daughter Sara Douglass is my G.Grandmother. & her daughter Rose Ann Weyand is my Grandmother on my fathers side.

According to a letter written by Sara Douglass, she states that James Douglass was born in County Antrim Irland about 1770 & came to Fairfield Co. S.C. in 1790. Sara al mentions that a cousin came with James, but we can't make out his Name in the letter. ( looks like it might be "Sturd" but we are not sure).

My Grandmother Rose Ann Weyand worked with Hiram Douglass in the early 50's on our Douglass genealogy, & she is mentioned in his book as " my cousin in Arkansas" hope this proves to be of some use. There is much more to this book than I have copied. Hiram had it published & distributed to the genealogical sections of the larger libraries in the South for the future use of Douglass decedents.

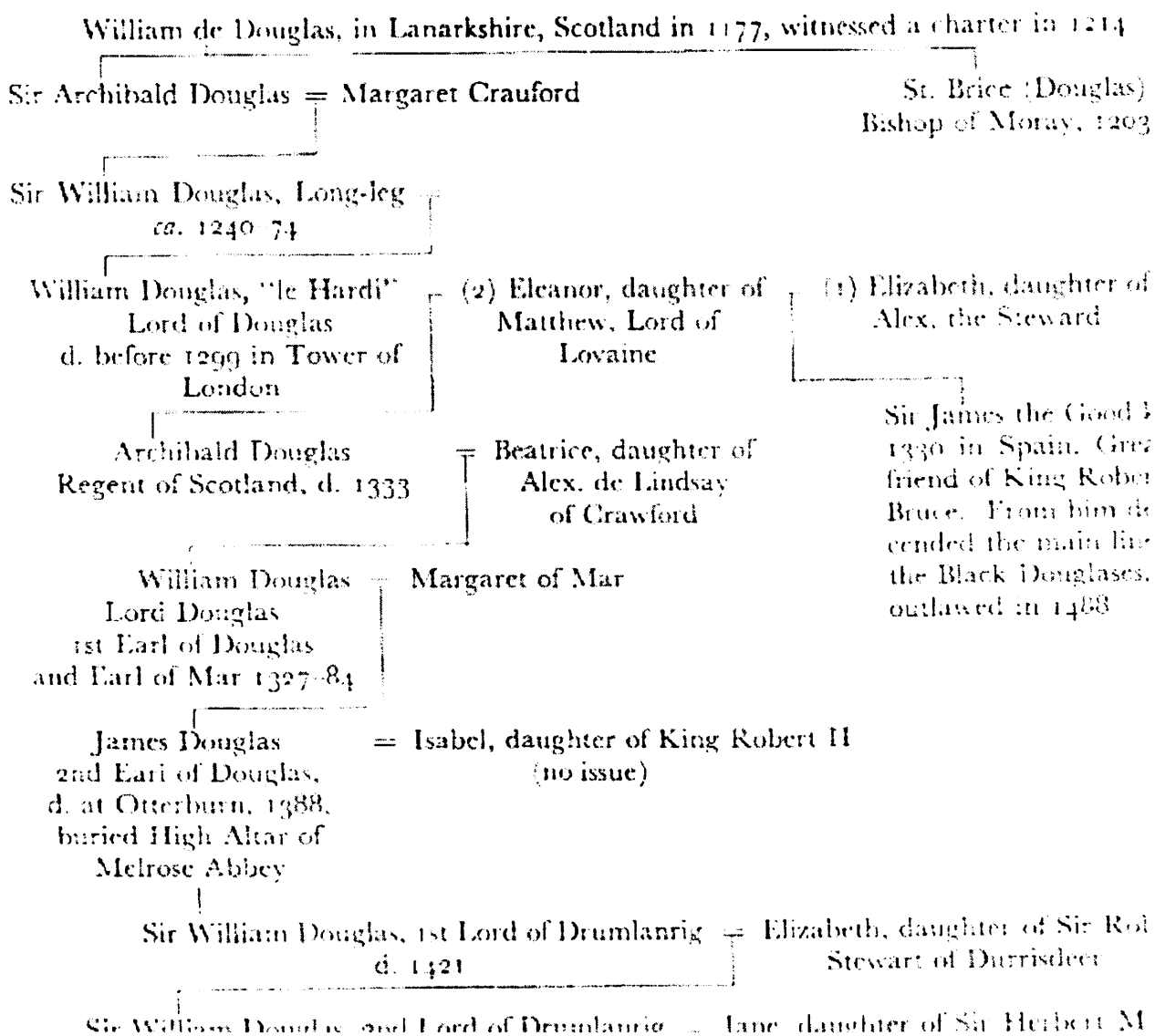

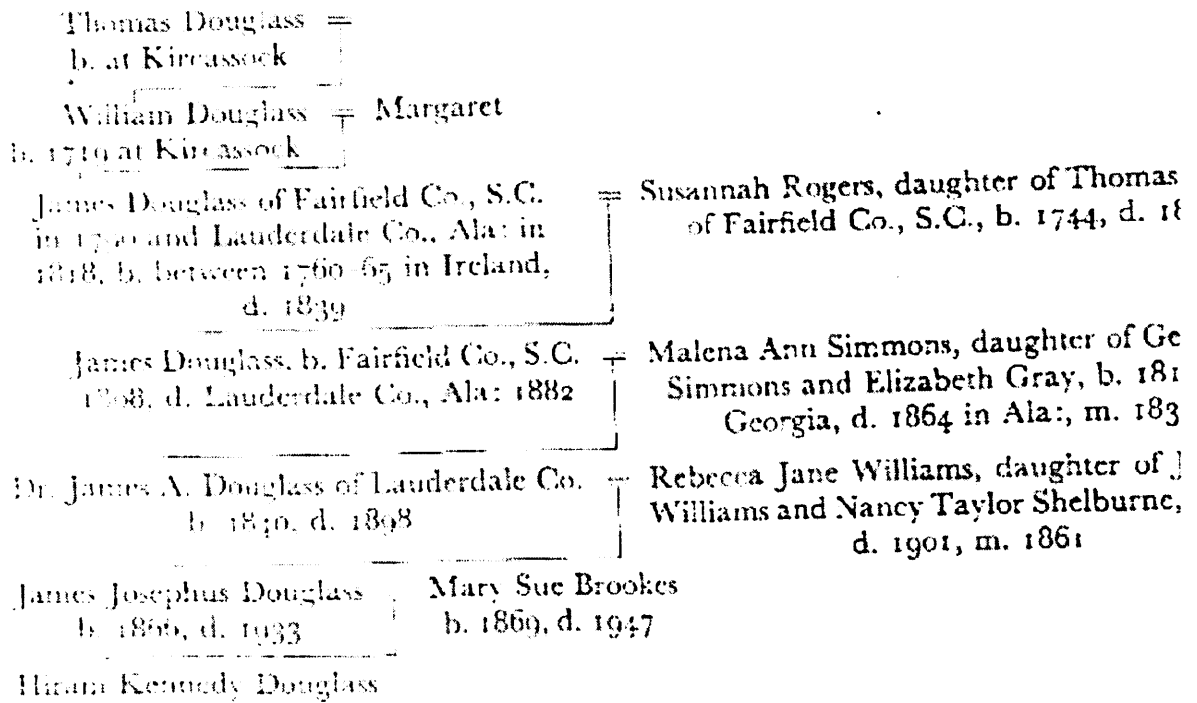
My Direct Line from the First Douglas of Record, through the Male Line of the BLACK Douglasses:

Dear George

I very much enjoyed meeting you at the Scottish Games in Charleston this past Saturday. As promised, I have enc some information on my Douglass family and hope it may be of some help to you.

My ancestor, James Douglass was born in County Antrim, Ireland between 1760 and 1765. He set sail for Charle SC in 1790 with his cousin Alexander Douglass, his wife Grace Brown and their two children John and Mary. Th arrived in Charleston in December of 1790 and settled in Fairfield County, SC, about six or eight miles west of Wainsboro.

Alexander and Grace had five sons born after getting to South Carolina. They were in addition to their first two children as follows:

John Douglass, born 1789 married Grace Jane Brice.

Mary Douglass died in May 1848, aged sixty years,  
 William Douglass, MD married a Miss Mobley.  
 James Douglass born 1805 and died January 5, 1867. ?  
 Alexander Douglass married Janet Simonton,  
 Charles Brown Douglass married Sara Jane Croshy,  
 Samuel Douglass married first a Miss Younge and second a Miss Reid.

James Douglass my forebearer married Susannah Rogers, daughter of Thomas Rogers of Fairfield Co., SC. James Susannah had seven children, all born in Fairfield Co., SC and they were as follows

Thomas Douglass was born May 22, 1793,  
 William Douglass was born September 14, 1796;  
 John Douglass was born December 6, 1799.  
 Abraham Douglass was born February 16, 1803,  
 Margaret Douglass was born October 22, 1808, *1805? (9wd)*  
 James Douglass (my forebearer) was born October 22, 1808; and  
 Robert Douglass who was born November 2, 1811.

William Douglass, the second son, does not appear on the land records in Lauderdale Co although four of his brothers are. He would have been 22 years old when the family went to Alabama, so it is probable that he stayed behind in South Carolina. John did not stay in Alabama, he is believed to have gone on to Bowie Co., Texas.

In the first census, 1790, there were in Virginia (36) Douglas(s) families, North Carolina, (13) and in South Carol. (25). Land grants to Douglas(s) in SC on file in the office of the Secretary of State in Columbia start as early as 1 and by 1774, thirty-eight grants had been made. These were all in the piedmont section of the State (Craves, now Chester Co., Edgefield, Sumter and Fairfield Counties)

If any of the above books promising in your quest for your early Douglass' please give me some additional details will be happy to dust off our family records and see what if anything we might have that could be helpful.


