

Douglas connections in America

The original Douglas came from Galloway, Scotland in the time of the persecution of the covenanters, in the reign of Charles II. Probably between 1660 and 1680

With many of their countrymen they may have entered Ireland by the River Bann and moved inland to the valley of the Maise in the Bullybuckety district, which is a stronghold of covenanters to this day.
