Now here is something really interesting: Doctor John Buchanan in Winnsboro was married to Mary Byers Douglas (we called her "Miss Mary"), and she was the daughter of William Davis Douglas. So Miss Mary was apparently named after her grandmother, Mary E. Byers Douglass, wife of Alexander Scott Douglas. I never knew that Miss Mary and her brother Mr. Moultrie Douglas were related this closely to Willie's and Margie's line. Doctor John and Miss Mary were married at Saint John's Episcopal Church in Winnsboro on November 9, 1929. All of that information is in "The History of Saint John's Episcopal Church" by Sharon Goff Avery. Gene could probably read a copy of it at the Fairfield public library.

So, none of this gets to Gene's question of wanting to know more about the original Mary E. Byers Douglass...but my guess is that a lot of information could be found in Spartanburg. Maybe Doug Marion could help fill in some of the blanks.

l attached the photo of Alexander Jr. and Jennett Simonton Douglass.

Thanks so much for all the wonderful information. I had never seen the grand jury papers.

Alexander Scott Douglas (sometimes mistakenly listed as Alexander Simonton Douglas) was the son of Alexander Douglass, Jr. and Jennett Simonton. His photo is in the "History of Spartanburg County" However, it appears that someone has cropped the wrong photo from the composite listed in the book in your document. The caption looks like it refers to the one in your document. However, if you look closely at the sides of the page you will see small numbers beside the photos, which correspond to the numbered captions. I believe he is on the lower right, and not the left. I photoshopped him out of the composite. See what you think.

You are right. Albion was built by Alexander Douglass, Jr. It was inherited by his son, John Simonton Douglas, and then by his son William Boyce Douglas. William was not a success at farming according to one family member. He died fairly young. His youngest brother, Albert Gilmer Douglas "bought out his brothers and sisters" and owned the house. Albert was a merchant in Columbia, S.C. and used the house as a retreat. He became ill and retired his family to the house. Later, when he recovered after about 2 years, he moved to High Point, NC and sold carpet. He maintained the house and it was inherited by his 3 children, Jack, Frances and Pauline. Jack wound up with the house and was selling it when I was moving back to Chester in 1986. I wanted it, but it was not practical to live 25 miles out in the country. Marge Woods, from Clover, SC, whose second husband, Bobby Woods was descended from John Douglas, the brother of Alexander, Jr. bought the house and restored it beautifully. I think she and her daughter still own the house. Thanks for the Fairfield Sketchbook write ups.

I think Alexander Douglass, Jr. would be the uncle of Thomas Goulding. Charles B. Douglas would be Alexander, Jr's brother. Right?

The pictures are great. I got some information that I had never seen.

Keep it coming. This is great!
