**"LAURA GLENN DOUGLAS AND HER ART"
ON DISPLAY JANUARY 6 - FEBRUARY 26**

CHARLESTON, SC...An exhibition of paintings by noted South Carolina artist Laura Glenn Douglas will be sponsored by South Carolina National. The collection featuring South Carolina and European images will be on display at the Gibbes Art Gallery Jan. 6 - Feb. 26, 1989. After exhibitions in Columbia, Charleston, Spartanburg and Winnsboro, Douglas' sketches, drawings and paintings from 1921 to 1958 will be permanently housed at the State Museum.

Laura Glenn Douglas (1886-1962), a Winnsboro native, left South Carolina in 1921 to pursue a career as an artist. She spent six years in New York attending several schools, including the National Academy of Design, the Art Students League, and the Women's Art School of the Cooper Union. From New York she traveled to Europe, working, exhibiting and studying in France, Germany and Italy between 1927 and 1934.

"As a South Carolina based bank, South Carolina National is excited about restoring the works of such an outstanding South Carolina artist and bringing them back to the state for permanent display," said James G. Lindley, chairman, South Carolina National Corporation. SCN currently owns one of the largest corporate art collections in the state.


