- The objects shall be exhibited under appropriate conditions of security, including fastenings or locked containers for small items; an attendant shall be present in the exhibit area whenever visitors are present and the exhibit area shall be secured during non-visitation hours. In the event of loss or theft of an object the borrower shall reimburse the Museum in the amount listed for it on the loan form.
- 4) The objects shall not be repaired, retouched, reproduced, nor altered in any way except with written permission from the South Carolina State Museum.
- 5) The objects shall not be lent to other organizations without <u>written</u> permission from the South Carolina State Museum.
