① John Douglas, our grandfather, was ^{Larn} born in Bellymana, Antrim County, Ireland, about ^{20 JAN 1797} 1789. He was brought to this country when an infant. He died October 26th, 1872, at his home in Fairfield County, South Carolina, four miles east of Blackstock, where he owned a great deal of land and many slaves. He was married Feb. 11th, 1819 to Grace Jane Brice. The names of their children are as follows:

- A - William Douglas, born March 6th, 1820, died about Feb. 29, 1896.
 - B - Alex Douglas, born Dec. 3rd, 1821, died about 1897.
 - C - John Douglas, born Sept. 16th, 1823, died Dec. 9th, 1887.
 - D - Grace Jane Douglas Sloan, born July 18, 1825, died Oct. 14, 1854
 - E - James Douglas, born March 10, 1827, died August 21, 1904.
 - F - Charles Douglas, born Feb. 10, 1829, lives at Wainsboro, S. C.
 - G - Elizabeth Phillips Douglas Irwin, born Dec. 19, 1830, lives in Texas.
 - H - Robert Leroy Douglas, born May 31, 1835, died 1866.
- Grace Jane Brice Douglas, our grandmother, died July 3, 1857.

Her husband, John Douglas, died fifteen years later. He was noted for his great physical strength and piety, and strict observance of Sunday.

2 - Mollie Douglas never married, nothing more said.

4 ③ William Douglas married a Miss Mobley, contrary to the wishes of his family. It is said that the objection was on account of some idiotic or idiosyncratic tendencies of the woman. But William Douglas realized that he was not in the Old Country, but on Free America where every man has greater liberty and is more of a sovereign, than a king, in the fact that he picks his own wife. The marriage seems to have been a happy ^{one} if we may judge from the number of children. Their names are as follows:

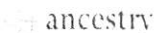
