CHAPIN, S.C. - A memorial service for Mrs. Christine Duncan will be held on Saturday November 17, 2012 at 11 am at Faith Presbyterian Church, 1811 Dutch Fork Road, Irmo, SC 29063 with Rev. Karl MacAllister officiating. Visitation will be from 9 am until 11 am the same day, at the church. Mrs. Duncan's bodily remains will be transferred to Germany and interred at her home town.

Christine Duncan, 48 of Chapin, died late Monday night October 22, 2012 at her residence. A daughter of Erhard and Ilse Batrla, she was born on February 19, 1964, in Münchberg, Germany. It was there she went to Elementary and High School, graduating in 1984. She enrolled at the University of Bamberg, graduating in 1991 with a Diploma in German Language. As an exchange student she came to the University of South Carolina, graduating in 1990 with a Master of Arts in Comparative Literature, and stayed on to graduate with a Master of Business Administration in 1992. Mrs. Duncan worked as an Office Administrator before deciding to be a homemaker, home schooling both of her sons. Recently, she worked teaching at Palmetto State E-Cademy as a learning coach.
