G.W. died from a stroke a few hours, after beings found by a negro hiredhand in his tobacco patch. Confederate; Voluntered with Arcadia Invincibles, these men were from Terryville community, and was part of Co.B Louisiana Infantry. He was promoted to Corporal Nov. 1863. Paroled at end of Civil War, 1865 at Greensboro, NC. G.W. carried a bullet in his shoulder received during the war until his death.

G.W. Dye went to Salem community, Claiborne Co.LA, Abt. 1853, with his then father-inlaw William H.Colvin.He was a Baptist, but went to Salem Methodist church with his wife and children.

Campaign under Gen.Braxton Bragg. He was taken to Gratiot street Federal Prison,St.Louis,MO. and was released Feb.13,1863 by a prison exchange, he took the oath of Renunciation and Allegiance to the Union. Reinlisted in C.S.A June 16,1863 at Ellistown,MS. Pvt.Co.E.2nd Reg't Miss.State Cavalry until wars end.

Alferd came to Pontotoc co.MS. between 1846/49, and was living with his sister Margaret and husband Meridith Taylor by
