Coat of Arms with numerous variations by the ancient and honorable Dee or Dee family of England is described in the heraldic terms as follows:

Arms: Argent, a fess sable, in chief three mullets of the second.

Another variation: Argent, a fess wavy azure between three mullets gules.

Crest: On a ducal coronet or a swan with wings endorsed, ducally gorged proper.
