

George Dye Sen. departed this life in the Spring  
of 1846. leaving a will dated some time in September  
1841. by which he wills all his property, real & personal  
to three of his children namely George L. Mary and  
Nancy Dye - Except \$10.00 to each of his other  
Children - Since the making of his will in September  
<sup>1841</sup> as aforesaid. he purchased some real property,  
say. a small lot of 2 or 3 acres of James Castles  
on which the dwelling house and other improvements  
stands for which he gave some three or four  
hundred dollars, also a small tract of seven or  
eight acres of William Hedgepeth worth some  
Eighty or ninety dollars - which said real property  
cannot pass by the will aforesaid. and must  
be sold for a division among the heirs of  
the said George Dye Sen. which are as follows  
Sarah Beam (wife of John Beam), the legal heirs of  
Daniel Dye (namely. Elijah, Martha, John, Baylis, & Sarah E)  
Elizabeth Widener, (widow of Abram Widener) Elijah Dye,  
Jemima Hooppaw (wife of Doris Hooppaw) John Dye  
Mary Dye, Nancy Dye, & George L Dye share  
and share alike - December 11<sup>th</sup> 1846 -
