



You grace the home with charms so fair, in muslin and in lace.


The days, the years, they pass

no longer is it dead!





ORIGIN OF THE EDRINGTON NAME

EDRINGTON is a location surname, acquired by those settlers who resided in the Adder River Valley near the town of Berwick-Upon-Tweed in Berwickshire Scotland. The name was originally sounded ADDER-ING-TUN, which meant "a people or farm located on the Adder River." The name "ADDER" is of Celt/Scottish origin, not English. Some etymologists think that this name is derived from the ODER River in Central Europe, the area from which the Celtics/Scots originally migrated. The "TUN" part of the name comes from the Old English form meaning "TOWN", which eventually evolved into "TON." The "ING" is simply a connector between the two words. By the year 1095 the name was spelled HADRYNGTON and by 1330 the more recognizable spelling of EDERINGTON was used.

The name Edrington can also be spelled as Etherington, Ethrington or Ederington. In old English the "th" (known as the soft "d") was frequently substituted for the letter "d." When researching the Edrington name in England the Etherington name should be treated as snynonymous. Christopher Edrington, who appears to be the ancestor of all Edringtons and Ederingtons in the United States, did spell his name as Etherington in some documents, as did some of his early ancestors. However, today all known descendants of Christopher only use the Edrington or Ederington spellings.

Another group of surnames possibly related to Edrington include Etherton, Edenton, Ethrington, Edington and Ethington. These names may all have a common origin in the United States from the Edenton/Eddington family found in Middlesex Co. Va. in the late 1600's. Descendants of this family appear to have moved to Spotsylvania Co. Va., and from there to Kentucky and Tennessee.

THE EDRINGTON FAMILY IN ENGLAND

Although the exact origin of **Christopher Edrington**, the original immigrant to America, cannot be absolutely proven at this time, there's no doubt that he came from England. During the mid 1600's almost all the families with the Edrington or Etherington surname resided in the counties of Yorkshire and Lancashire in England. Logically then, a search for the parents of Christopher Edrington should be centered in those areas.

Through a querying of the International Genealogical Index in the LDS Church Archives in Salt Lake City, conducted by LaMar K. Edrington of LaPoint Utah, it was determined that the most probable origin for Christopher Edrington was the following family:

CHRISTOPHER ETHERINGTON, b. 1592, d. 1669, m. *Alice Ullstrom*, b. c.1597, they resided in the town of Ugglebarnby, Whitby Parish in Yorkshire County England. Children:

- 1. William Etherington, b. c. 1626.
- 2. Christopher Etherington, b. c. 1629.
- 3. Thomas Etherington, b. c. 1631.

Checking the first son William, it was determined that he apparently stayed in England. As eldest son, it's likely that he inherited the estate of his father Christopher who died in 1669. No record was found in England for the descendants of the other two sons Christopher and Thomas, who would have been "left out in the cold" when their father died.

Using LDS records, LaMar K. Edrington was able to determine the following line of descent for Christopher Etherington (b. 1592):

Christopher Etherington's great-great-great-grandfather was William Etherington who married Alice Skerne, dau. of Richard Skerne. His great-great-grandfather was Randell Etherington who married Janet Constable, dau. of Robert Constable & Agnes Wentworth. His great-grandfather was Sir Knight Thomas Etherington who married Elizabeth Southby, dau. of Thomas Southby. His grandfather was Christopher Etherington who married Margaret Middlewood, dau. of William Middlewood. His father was Christopher Etherington who married Alice ???

While there are no birthyears attached to this line of descent, if one assumes a new generation every 30 years, it's probable that William Etherington was born in the mid 1400's.

The first record of a Christopher Edrington in America is found in 1666, as recorded in Deed Book #3 of Old Rappahannock Co. Va.:

I Susannah Spearman doe constitute and appoynt **Xpr. Edrington** to acknowledge all my right Title and Interrest of 200 acres of land sold by me and my husband onto Collo. John Catlett to say my right & title as to my thirds or Dower for the wch I doe acknowledge my Selfe fully Satisfyed by Collo. John Catlett. In witness whereof I have sett my hand & seale this 24th. day of August 1666. Signed Susannah Spearman. Test. Alex Fleming & John Prosser. Recorded 12th. day of September 1666.

THE EDRINGTON FAMILY IN AMERICA

FIRST GENERATION

1 CHRISTOPHER EDRINGTON I, possibly son of Christopher Etherington & Alice Ullstrom, was born around 1629 in England, d. c.1678 Old Rappahannock Co. Va., resided in Old Rappahannock Co. Va. by 1666, m. c.1671, *Mrs. Margaret Jennings*, possibly dau. of John Payne (she m. 1st. John Jennings by whom she had 6 children), b. ??? , d. c.1684/85 Old Rappahannock Co. Va.

As noted above, Christopher Edrington is first found in the records of Old Rappahannock Co. Va. in 1666. In 1670 he witnessed a number of deeds between Margaret Jennings, widow and executrix of John Jennings, to her children John, William, Grace, Jane, Margaret & Honor Jennings (Old Rappahannock Deed Book #4, pgs. 293-298 & 336-338). It is believed that shortly after 1670 he married the widow Mrs. Margaret Jennings. In 1672 Christopher witnessed land deeds between Thomas Parker & Richard Shepard (Old Rappahannock Co. Deed Book #4, pgs. 477-478 & Deed Book #5, pgs. 267). In 1674 Christopher Edrington & Thomas Everest purchased from Henry Berry 350 acres of land in Stafford Co. Va. (Old Rappahannock Co. Deed Bk. 1672-1676 Pt. II, pgs. 244-245 & Deed Book #5, pgs. 395-396). Thomas Everest appears to have been the husband of Christopher's step-daughter Margaret Jennings. It has been speculated that this 350 acres in Stafford Co. may be the land that eventually became the Edrington "home place" in Stafford Co.

Christopher Edrington died sometime before 1682, when his wife Margaret wrote her will, describing herself as a widow. No will or estate settlement records have ever been found for Christopher. Margaret was still alive in 1684 when she was ordered to appear at court to testify relavant to a bastard child born to Jane Foster (Old Rappahannock Co. Order Bk. 1683-1686, pgs. 28 & 47). On 4 Mar. 1685 the will of *Margrett Edrington* of Sittingburne Parish was recorded (Old Rappahannock Co. Will Bk. 1682-1687, pg. 43). She divided her estate among her three sons, John Jennings, William Jennings & Christopher Edrington. The will was witnessed by Francis & Elizabeth Stone, the Stone family later being associated with the Edringtons in Stafford Co. Va. Francis Stone & Giles Matthews were ordered to meet at the house of Margaret Edrington deceased

in order to divide the estate among the orphans (Old Rappahannock Co. Court Order Bk. 1683-1686, pg. 141). A precise division of Margaret's estate is recorded in Old Rappahannock Co. will book 1682-1687, pgs. 85-87.

SECOND GENERATION

2 CHRISTOPHER EDRINGTON II, son of Christopher Edrington I & Margaret Payne, b. c.1672 Sittingbourne Parish, Rappahannock Co. Va., d. c.1738 Hanover Parish, King George Co. Va., m. *Mary Payton/Jett*, b. c.1680, d. c.1756 Hanover Parish, King George Co. Va. The surname of Christopher's wife is still in doubt. Some sources identify her as a Payton and others as a Jett (perhaps due to Christopher's close association with the Jett family).

After the death of his mother Margaret in early 1685, Christopher was apparently placed in the care of John Bodington. It's likely that John Bodington was the husband of Christopher's half-sister Honor. In November 1685 Francis Stone was noted as security for John Bodington relevant to the delivery of estate to Christopher Edrington orphan (Old Rappahannock Co. Order Book 1683-1686, pg. 176). However, John Bodington died by 1687 and his widow remarried Henry Goring. The court ordered Goring to deliver to Christopher his estate (given to him by the will of his deceased mother) of which John Bodington died "possessed of" (Old Rappahannock Co. Order Book 1686-1692, pg. 74).

Christopher Edrington continued to live in Sittingbourne Parish in Old Rappahannock Co. Va., however in 1692 this area became part of the newly formed Richmond Co. Va. Christopher first appears on the records of that county in 1695 when he witnessed a deed of 100 acres of land from Adam Woffendall to Thomas Arnold. Woffendall's wife was named Honoria and one can't help but wonder if she was Christopher's half-sister Honor Jennings, who previously was married to John Bodington & Henry Goring.

On 6 Sept. 1699, an action brought by *Charles Edrington* against John Tarkinton was dismissed (Richmond Co. Orders 1697-1699, pg. 457). It's likely that the plaintiff was actually Christopher Edrington. On 4 Feb. 1702/03 an action against *Christopher Edington* by Alexander Spence was also dismissed (Richmond Co. Orders 1702-1704, pg. 233). On 13 Apr. 1704 *Christopher Eddrington*, Nicholas Smith & William Pannell witnessed a deed of land from James & George Phillips to Paul Micou (Richmond Co. Deeds 1601-1704, pgs. 267-272).

On 4 Oct. 1704, Francis Sterne (Stone), Francis James, Christopher Ederington & Walter Anderson were ordered to meet at the house of Mary Triplett to inventory & appraise the estate of Francis Triplett (Richmond Co. Orders 1702-1704, pg. 367). Francis Triplett was the grandfather of Francis Triplett, who later married Christopher's daughter Mildred. On 16 Oct. 1704 Christopher Edrington was granted "8 dayes himselfe & horse for service done the country in takeing the Indians" while under the command of Nicholas Smith. Francis Stone was also granted compensation for this service (Colonial Abstracts, Vol. 17, Fleet).

On 23 Feb. 1707, Christopher Edrington, Mary Edrington & Christopher Edrington Jr., son of said Christopher & Mary, purchased the land on which they lived from Peter Jett (Richmond Co. Deed Bk. #4, pgs. 142A & 143). Christopher Jr. had apparently just been born, but neverthless he now had a life estate in this land, which may explain why he only received 10 shillings in his father's will. This land later fell into King George Co. upon its formation from Richmond Co. in 1721.

On 1 Feb. 1722, Xtopher Edrington and William Triplett appraised the estate of James Stotte (King George Co. Inventories 1721-1744, pg. 24). Christopher Edrington was sworn in as a member of two grand juries in May and November of 1723 (King George Co. Order Bk. 1, pgs. 118 & 139). In 1725 & 1726 he was an appraiser for the estates of John Pratt, George Seagood and Elizabeth Jett, and in 1733 for Joseph Ammon's estate (King George Co. Inventory Bk. 1). On 1 Nov. 1734, Christopher Edrington of Hanover Parish, King George Co., purchased for 25 pounds, 86 acres from John Jett of Washington Parish, Westmoreland Co. (King George Co. Deed Bk. 1-A, pgs. 313-314).

On 2 Feb. 1738/9, the will of Christopher Edrington of Hanover Parish was proven (King George Co. Va. Will Book A-1 1721-1752, pgs. 139-140). He left all his lands and slaves Bambo & Bess to his son John Ederington, slaves Jenny, Nell & Bob to his son William Ederington, slave Frank to his daughter Hester Ederington, and only ten shillings to his son Christopher Ederington (having previously received a life estate in land purchased from Peter Jett in 1707). He also left ten shillings each to his daughters Mary Quisenbury, Elizabeth Richardson, Sarah Ammon, Mildred Triplett and Susanna Hales. His wife Mary received slaves Beny, Pegg & Harry along with the rest of his estate. His sons William and John were named co-executors of his estate. The will was witnessed by Francis and Peter Jett.

On 5 Feb. 1756, the will of Christopher's widow Mary Edrington of Hanover Parish was proven (King George Co. Will Bk. A, pgs. 47-49). In the will she named her sons William and John Edrington, daughters Susanah Hails, Mildred Tripplet, Mary Quessenberry and Hester Elmns, and grandaughter Mildred Edrington. She also left possessions to Mary Baillett and Margaret Jett. Her son John Edrington and son-in-law Francis Tripplett were named co-executors of her estate. The will was witnessed by Thomas Vivion and Francis Jett.

Barnett Wilkerson & had children Robert & Nancy Wilkerson & m. 2nd. 3/30 Sept. 1817 Adair Co., Joseph Hardin & had children Logan, Sarah Ann & Nancy Hardin). Thomas & Judith parted about 1853 and he agreed that she should keep her property for her children.

Thomas and his brother William apparently moved from Fairfield Co. S.C. around 1802, settling in Green Co. Ky. near Wagoner's Bend, where they bought over 1000 acres of wild land, upon which they built a farm. The 1810 census showed this area still in Green Co., but by 1820 the land was apparently part of Adair Co. Ky. Thomas resided on this land until his death in 1859. Thomas was an Ensign in the 16th. Regiment (enlisted on 28 May 1803 in Green Co.) of the Corn Stalk Brigade of Ky. Thomas was also a veteran of the War of 1812, enlisting on 7 Mar. 1815 as a Sergeant in Capt. Lyddall Bacon's Co. of the Kentucky Militia, commanded by Lt. Col. John Francisco. Children:

To illustrate how many published genealogical biographies are in error is the following example. From a sketch of his grandson R.P. Edrington in A Memorial & Biographical History of Hill Co. Tx. is this description of Thomas: "Thomas Edrington was born in Virginia, but moved from there to Kentucky at an early date. He built boats and shipped tobacco to New Orleans. He was a large planter and slave owner." While interesting, most of this information appears to be in error. Although Thomas was born in Virginia his family moved to South Carolina and from there they moved to Kentucky. Also, there's no evidence that Thomas built boats nor shipped tobacco to New Orleans. His estate consisted of personal property only and he died without a will, so it doesn't seem likely that he was a large planter nor a slave owner.

From a sketch of his son Delouvois Edrington in the *History of Kentucky, Edition 4* (by Perrin, Battle & Kniffen) is the following description of Benjamin: "Prior to marrying, Benjamin taught several years in the common schools. Soon after marrying, he bought a partially improved farm near Cane Valley, Adair Co. Ky. He resided there for two or three years, after which he sold out and bought a farm on the Green River in Adair Co. near Wagoner's Bend. After a few years he sold this place also and bought another near Columbia Ky., remaining until about 1841, when he left the county and moved to Livingston Co. Mo. He remained there for two years and then returned to his farm in Adair Co. (Another source states that he came to Mo. in 1843 and returned to Ky. in the spring 1844). There he remained for two years until 1850, when he sold the farm and went back to Livingston Co. He settled on a farm near Chillicothe that he had bought some years before and engaged in agricultural pursuits and for two years also in general merchandise. In 1863 he sold out and moved to Plymouth, Hancock Co. Ill., where he engaged in merchandising for nearly two years. In April 1865 he returned to Adair Co. Ky. and bought a farm near Cane Valley, upon which he resided until his death."

From a sketch of his son R.P. Edrington in A Memorial & Biographical History of Hill Co. Tx. is another description of Benjamin's life: "Benjamin Edrington moved to Livingston Co. Mo. in 1848. There be bought and improved a farm, and after a few years of successfully tilling the soil, he invested the profits in the mercantile business in company with his brother-in-law, W.P. Settles. He subsequently sold his interest in the store and returned to the farm where he remained eight or ten years. From there he went to Chillicothe and engaged in buying and prizing tobacco in company with Joseph Davis. After one year he became sole proprietor and continued in this business until 1864, at which time the Union forces took possession of the buildings, converting them into a commissary department and livery barn. When vacated they were unfit for use. While engaged in the tobacco business Mr. Edrington took stock in the Bank of Chillicothe Mo. of which he afterward became a director. From that city he removed to Illinois, where he was engaged in

merchandising for one year, and then settled near Columbia Ky. where he continued in the same business in Cane Valley, in connection with agricultural pursuits. Several years later he disposed of the store to his sons, Thomas and DeLouvois, and continued on the farm until his death.'

"He was a man of very decided convictions and was not capable of being moved when his conscience approved of any measure. He was a secessionist from principle, and he indicated his convictions by utterly refusing to take the oath of allegiance. While he was stern, and governed in all his actions strictly by the dictates of his conscience, he elicited the good will and profound regard of all those with whom he was associated. He had received a good English education in his youth, and this he supplemented by observation and close reading, becoming one of the well informed men of the day. He was naturally of a mathematical turn of mind, and became quite proficient in surveying. For about 40 years he was an active member of the Christian church, and for a number of years prior to his death served as Elder."

From a sketch of Delouvois Edrington in the History of Kentucky, Edition 4 (by Perrin, Battle & Kniffen) is the following description of his life: "Delouvois received a good common-school and academic education in youth, including a thorough Latin Course. In June 1861 he enlisted in Company E., First Missouri Volunteer Infantry (Confederate) and served until Feb. 1862, when he was taken prisoner at Springfield Mo., but was soon after paroled and returned home. He participated in the battles of Carthage Mo., Wilson's Creek Mo., Dry Wood, and Lexington Mo. After his return from the army, he farmed one year and in April 1863 he started for California in the company of some 50 or 60 emigrants, who accomplished the entire journey across the plains with an ox team, arriving in California in September. From Sacramento he went to Virginia City Nv., where he was engaged in mining for a short time. After this he went to Dayton Nv., where he was employed as a chemist for a quartz mining company for nearly 1-1/2 years. He then went to San Francisco and from there returned to his father's home in Plymouth Ill. In the fall of 1865 he went to St. Louis Mo., where he took a regular commercial course.'

"The next year he opened a general store at Cane Valley, Adair Co. Ky., where he remained for two years. In 1870 he moved his stock to Rolla Ky., where he continued the business for some 5 years. In 1875 he sold the stock and bought a farm of 140 acres on Casey Creek, on a part of which the village of Rolla has since been built. There he successfully raised stock, grew tobacco and later corn. For several years he was deputy county clerk of Adair Co. (actually one year!) and later was the postmaster at Rolla. Delouvois & Mrs. Edrington belonged to the Christian Church, where he officiated as a deacon for many years. He also belonged to the Masonic fraternity, having been Worthy Master of his lodge for several years, and later secretary. Politically he was a democrat."

Delouvois & Sarah resided Casey Creek, Adair Co. Ky. 1880 through 1887, but by 1893 they lived in Ballard, Bates Co. Mo. After Delouvois' death, Sarah resided in Butler, Bates Co. Mo. 1910.

From A Memorial & Biographical History of Hill Co. Tx. is the following description of R.P. Edrington: "No name is justly entitled to a more enviable place in the history of Hill Co. Tx., than the one which heads this sketch, for it is borne by a man ho has been usefully and honorably identified with the interests of the county, and with its advancement in every worthy particular.'

"R.P. Edrington, the subject of this sketch, was originally from Kentucky where he remained with his parents until 1869. When 15 years of age he began to assist his father in the management of the business. His educational advantages were good. He completed the course at the Columbia College, and afterward spent one year in the Kentucky University. His first business venture was buying and selling mules and hogs, and this his father encouraged by furnishing the necessary money. Mr. Edrington then studied medicine for a short time in compliance with his father's wish, but not liking it, gave it up and came West.'

"He first settled in Files' Valley, and embarked in the cattle business, which proved profitable until the winter of 1873-74, when he lost all he had made. However, he continued to deal in stock, and in 1875 he bought 110 acres, which he tilled in connection with stock-raising until 1887. He then assisted in organizing the Farmers' National Bank of Hillsboro, and was made cashier. He remained there 3 years. In 1890, in company with others, he organized the Itasca Banking Company which was nationalized Nov. 21 of the same year, with a capital of \$50,000."

"Mr. Edrington began for himself when 21 year of age with nothing, and he now owns over 1200 acres of land, well stocked and well improved, also town property and bank stock. He has not only acquired a competency, but by his upright course in business has gained the confidence and esteem of the entire community. He is a man of enterprise, intelligence, and strictly honorable principles, and his labors have met with most pleasing results from a pecuniary point of view. He has been a resident of this county for many years, having from the very first identified himself with its material progress and development, and his career has been one that reflects great credit upon him."


