The Rev. James Rogers, a native of County Monaghan Ireland, was pastor of Ebenezer ARP Church in 1791. He was twice married. His first wife was Jane Wilson Murray, the second was Gelia Davis, third Jane Adger - all natives of Fairfield.

The Hanahan House at 100 Zion St. was built by Mr. Adger, who sold it to Mrs. Cathcart when he moved to his plantation home at Adger (see attached History of Adgerland). The house on Zion St. is now occupied by Miss Rebecca Hanahan. The home at Adger was occupied by Mr. John H. Cathcart at the time of its sale. Also the house was occupied at one time by the Long family at least they are mentioned as living on a plantation at Adger
