transient and missed the 1870 census either by traveling or working back in forth.

He apparently missed the 1910 census also.

the 1870 Census for his future wife, Catherine "Kattie" or "Cattie" Brown;

the 1880 & 1900 census;

SC Death Record:

Death Certificate.

If you need information on tombstone or grave:

did not find anything on find a grave for cemetery in North or South Carolinas;

Death Certificate states he was buried in Chester County;

our records that we do have for Chester County are tombstone dates older than Charles;

check with King Funeral Home in Chester, Chester County, South Carolina for assistance,

they may be able to help locate grave.

You may be able to get some assistance for Chester County records or even census at either the Chester County Library Resource Section or Chester County Genealogy Society.







Additionally, the names of those listed on the population schedule are linked to actual images of the 1870 Federal Census.


