The Ellison's:

Charles Ellison was born 1853 somewhere in NC. Charles and wife Katie was found in the 1880 census and again in Chester, SC in 1900. Their Children were ,Walker, Loffy, Carrie and William. In 1900 their children were: William, Bose, Charles, Quay and Jessie. Charles was a wagon driver. In 1930 I see Katie alone with a niece named Juanita Jones. Katie was 66. I see that one of her children Walker (My GGandFather) and His family was also in Chester at this time. *Note: I* know that a Robert E Ellison Jr was a BIG plantation owner at the time. I cant help but wonder if Charles was some how related. Their children had similar names and I feel that Charles must have had Relatives in Winnsboro's and that's why he moved there. Lastly, I found Charles death certificate. It lists his mother as a Charlotte Easley or Easley. The handwriting is trouble. No father listed oddly. Charles died in Chester, 1937.

The Goins:

In Winnsboro's .I have found that Katie mother and fathers were Evan and Fannie (Rachel) Goins, I found this in the Winnsboro SC, 1870 census but Fanny's name is Rachel. There children were: Hainey, William, Amanda, Hester (f), James and Herbert. In 1880 I see Kates remarried to a Toney Toatley in Winnsboro, SC. The children in 1880 were: William, Herbert, Elizabeth, Alexander, and A (Yamms? sp) in 1880.

I also found a Ruben James in our family from Winnsboro SC; the census shows him working at a Fairfield Inn, .My GG Grand father Rubin James, Born 1850, and no record of death certificate. He married Jane, (Genera), not sure this is a last name Born 1853, no record of death certificate. Rubin and Jane's daughter Minnie, married Walker Ellison, Walker was Charles son, and Minnie was Ruben James Daughter.

<u>*Special note</u>: We have always known we came from native ancestry. I believe that our Native history comes from The Goins and Ellison line. My challenge is finding which line it comes from if possible.

The Kirk: Just started working this line so I don't have a lot to go on yet.

William Kirk. Born 1914, died 1961, Chester, Rock Hill. Williams Father, Elijah Kirk (this is the one that I am Currently trying to find). Born, 1878, Died 1937, born somewhere in NC, died in York County.
