The Ellisons:

Charles Ellison, born 1853 somewhere in NC and he died in Chester, SC in 1919, Herborm cemetery. Charles and wife Katie Ellison are found in the 1880 census and again in Chester in 1900. Their Children were: Walker, Lolly, Carrie and William. In 1900 their children were: William, Bose, Charles, Quay and Jessie. Charles was a wagon driver. In 1930 I see Katie alone with a niece named Juanita Jones. Katie was 66. I see that one of her children Walker (My Grandfather) and His family was also in Chester at this time. Note: I know that a Robert E Ellison Jr was a BIG plantation owner at the time. I cant help but wonder if Charles was some how related. In 1850 I see Mary Allison and some other Allisons from NC living in Fairfeild, (I wonder if this is a connection) The Big Robert Ellison and my Charles children had similar names and I feel that Charles must have had relative in SC and that's why he moved. I found Charles death certificate, it list his mother as a Charlotte Eusley or Easley. The handwriting is trouble. No father listed oddly. Charles Jr died in Chester, 1937, informant was a Emma Ellison from Charlotte. My first cousins name is Emma. I asked if she know of this Emma and of course she doesn't. Lastly, I see Charles Ellison(JR.)? living next door to Walker in 1910 but in the house hold of a John R. Guy. John is (30y) with wife Sophia, 27, James(S)7yrs and daughter Jamie(3)mths. Looks like another surname guy.

In Winnsboro. I have found that Katie Ellison mother and fathers were Evans and Fannie Goins, I found this in Winnsboro SC,1870 census. On Katie dealth notice it show her mother as being Fanny. On the 1870 censue it show Evans wife as a Rachel. Rachel must be the 2ed wife. I think Fanny died before 1880. There were children were: Hainey, William, Amanda, Hester, James and Herbert. In 1980 I see Kate and a Toney Toatley in Winnsboro, SC. The children in 1880 were: William, Hurbert, Elizabeth, Alexander, and a Yamms? in 1880. I think I see a Hurbert and Alexander Goins in Chester 1910 but haven't had a chance to look at it yet. On the Goins line, I just don't know that much.
