

Presbyterian Church - Zion Presbyterian  
Church

Location on Garden Street in Winnsboro  
Fairfield Co. S.C.

Zion Presbyterian Church was organized as  
preaching station in 1790. The Rev. Robert  
McCullough was preaching there at that time  
and Col. Wm. McCright was one of its 1st  
elders. In 1801 the Rev. John Foster was a  
pulpit supply for 2 yrs. Rev. George Reed was  
installed the 1st pastor in March 1805. The 1st  
building was begun in 1809 and finished in 1841  
and the 1st sermon preached in it was Sept  
of that year by Rev. B. R. Montgomery. In 1813  
the church gave a call to Rev. Anthony Rose  
In 1824 Mr. John McKenny from Pinney Branch  
supplied the pulpit for 9 months. The Rev. Wm  
Brearly came in 1825, he continued as pastor  
until 1841 - 16 years. The Rev. Samuel H. Hay  
was installed in 1844. Rev. James Douglass  
came in 1855. These were some of the  
pastors serving Zion up to the C. Confederate  
War. A new church building was  
completed in 1893, and it was not  
built on the same ground as the old  
old cemetery as formerly. The cemetery  
is in use and is well kept.
