I'm glad for you to have this,

My great granddad was William Eugene Ellison (W. E. Ellison) and this genealogy takes his line and some associated families from Antrim Ireland to his children in Oak Cliff Texas, near Dallas. I live within 50 miles of where his generation and his children all lived since the Civil War.

This genealogy was extracted from a family bible that W. E. had but that is now lost. These are scans of the best copies of this that I have and were handed down to me my my dad, who is still living.

As you will see, there are a couple of interesting tid-bits:

1. Our Robert Ellison is named here as Robert William Ellison b. 1742
2. The daughter that John Baily Adger and Clara Ellison Erath indicated moved to Camden district (Chester) with all the brothers is not listed. therefore no mention of the Mr. McCallister (spelling?) that I'm now looking for.
3. I am not related to Robert but to John, his brother, the same John Ellison that Clara Ellison Erath wrote about in her book "The Descendants of John and Robert Ellison.

He went into the Confederate Service ever age and was captain of Co. B 21 st Regiment S.C. Volunteers; refused promotion as colonel when the regiment was formed, to "remain with the boys"; was afterwards promoted over his protests to major, commanding his regiment most of the time in Va. He was three times wounded, taken prisoner and held at the old Capitol prison in Washington, and then at Ft. Delaware, till Jan. 25, 1865, at the close of of the war. He died from the effects of exposure and wounds, Oct. 29, 1869.
