Thanks so much for your email response. I apologize if you tried to reach me today by phone; it turned out to be a busy day away from home-/and a stormy night! (We are leaving town in the morning for a long weekend, also, and will be home by Monday.) But, I do want to let you know how much I appreciate the good information which you included in your email. I'd certainly like to contact Mrs. Morton; perhaps she could help me learn something about the writer of the letter, Martha A. Feaster, to my great-grandmother, Susan Summerow. I have wondered about her and her family ever since finding the letter in Susan's Family Bible. She married George W. Hines in 1871. He was a veteran of the Civil War, Co B, 28th Regt, NC Troops. The Bible was a treasure trove of Susan's written keepsakes. Martha's letter is a delight. I will send you a transcription. I had it framed between two pieces of glass, and it is difficult to copy in that state (tho, finding descendants who would want a suitable copy, I would be glad to disassemble the framed original to make such a copy).

I have fond memories of visiting friends in Winnsboro; never dreamed Feasterville was close by!
