Obituary

CARLOUS FORD BURRELL, DAUGHTER OF THE LATE PAUL W. FORD, SR. AND ADELINE KITCHEN-FORD, WAS BORN IN WINNSBORO, SOUTH CAROLINA ON OCTOBER 19, 1912, AND DEPARTED THIS LIFE AT PRINCE GEORGE'S HOSPITAL, CHEVERLY, MARYLAND FEBRUARY 26, 2004, AFTER A LONG ILLNESS. SHE WAS THE WIFE OF THE LATE DEACON HEYWARD BURRELL, SR.

CARLOUS WAS EDUCATED IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN WINNSBORO, SOUTH CAROLINA. AFTER COMPLETING HER EDUCATION, SHE MET AND MARRIED HEYWARD. AFTER THEIR MARRIAGE, HEYWARD AND CARLOUS MOVED TO NEW YORK, WHERE THEY LIVED FOR ONE YEAR. DURING THAT YEAR THEIR FIRST SON HEYWARD, JR. WAS BORN. AFTER LEAVING NEW YORK THEY MOVED TO WASHINGTON D. C. WHERE THEIR SECOND (2ND) SON, CARL WAS BORN. HERE SHE INVOLVED HERSELF FOR OVER SEVENTY (70) YEARS IN CHRISTIAN & CIVIC ACTIVITIES.

LIVING IN NORTHWEST D.C. ALWAYS PUTTING GOD FIRST IN HER LIFE, CARLOUS JOINED VERMONT AVENUE BAPTIST CHURCH. LATER SHE MOVED TO SOUTHEAST WASHINGTON WHERE SHE WAS ONE OF THE FOUNDERS OF FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF MARSHALL HEIGHTS.
