DAM WAS BUILT BY J.G. WHITE AROUND THE TIME OF THE FIRST WORLD WAR. NANCY'S BROTHER, CHARLES FREE, MOVED OVER INTO NEWBERRY COUNTY AND HER BROTHERS, NATHAN, MANUEL, AND DAVID FREE HAD MOVED NEAR COLUMBIA, S.C. IN 1921, NANCY AND DAVID WILSON MOVED TO 13000 BUSH RIVER ROAD, LEXINGTON COUNTY, IN THE ST. ANDREWS COMMUNITY. "DAVE"AND HIS SON, JOSEPH WILSON, DROVE THE HORSES AND WAGONS AND THE OTHERS RODE IN THE CAR WHEN THEY MOVED TO THEIR NEW HOME AND 50 ACRES OF LAND. OF THIS LAND, 7 ACRES WAS BELOW THE COLUMBIA, NEWBERRY, AND LAURENS RAILROAD. THE BROAD RIVER POWER COMPANY WANTED TO BUY THREE OF THESE ACRES BUT "DAVE" WILSON WOULDN'T SELL ANY UNLESS THEY BOUGHT ALL 7 ACRES, WHICH THEY DID. (THIS WAS ON THE SALUDA RIVER) AFTER "DAVE" AND NANCY DIED, THE LAND REMAINING WAS SOLD AND IS NOW THE BUSH RIVER MALL.
