There were Jacob Gibson Sr., Jacob Gibson Jr. and Jacob Gibson III, in Fairfield County, South Carolina. Yes, they were father and sons. The Jacob Gibson in Laurens County, South Carolina may trace back to Virginia or across the pond but we do not think this Jacob is closely related to the Fairfield County, Jacob Gibson's.

I have attached the early census for Jacob Gibson's in South Carolina.

Also attached is the last will and testament and excerpts of references for Jacob Gibson, Sr. provided by Russell A. Puricelli of Dawson, Georgia and with his permission as long as information is used for personal research only and not for resale.

We have a lot of information on the Gibson's of Fairfield County, however, I hope this helps resolve your questions.

Mr. Killian,

I am looking for some information on a Jacob Gibson that came to Fairfield county in the 1700's. I spoke with a lady at the Fairfield County Museum and she recommended that I contact you. The individual I am inquiring about is the Jacob Gibson that started the Little River Baptist Church. According to 1790 Census, there were 2-Jacob Gibson's living in Fairfield county. Do you know if those two were father and son?

I have an ancestor, Jacob Gibson, who was in Laurens County in 1790. He came from Prince William County, Virginia. He lived in Laurens County for about 10 years after he got out of the Revolutionary War. He moved from Laurens County to Barren County, Kentucky where he remained the rest of his life. Many family trees on Ancestry.com have his father as the Jacob Gibson in Fairfield. Some have his father as an Abraham Gibson from Fauquier County, Virginia. I am needing to know if there is any possibility that the Jacob Gibson in Fairfield is the father of my Jacob Gibson that was in Laurens County. If the two Jacob's that is listed in Fairfield county is father and son then I guess that would automatically rule him out. Any information or help you can provide would be greatly appreciated!!!
