" I, Jacob Gibson of Camden District
beloved wife Sarah Gibson. --- care and industry shall be
used on my plantation none to have residence on it that
shall abuse - - - to be idle or contentious Sons, Able and James
Sons Jacob and Joseph, Sons David and Stephen son Benjamin. Who ever
shall take Benjamin shall have all the priviledges of what they can
make of my lands and my fathers in Va. Isahell, my beloved
Judith (dau) Lucy a dau, Pisciella a dau. I appint my dear and
well beloved Friends and Brothers in the Lord Thomas Halsel, John Kennerly
with my beloved son Jacob Gibson, Hill made Dec. 8, 1784 signed Thomas
Bansare, Jesse Bansar, Elizabeth Kennerly, Jacob Gibson originally Penn came from
