April 10, 1771 by William L. Austin

In Wm. Martens History of Fairfield

also James, Edward + Bobt in Semmel war  
in war between the States private H. J.,  
and W. J. A. Nelson

Joseph not in 1829 Census

Jacob Nelson came to Fairfield from  
North Carolina in 1762. He was a Baptist minister  
and a teacher. He was a sound practical  
scholar and a practical preacher. There is no  
calculating the good which resulted from  
his labors, love and patience. He spent  
40 years in the ministry. He died about  
the year 1796.

We find Joseph mentioned three times  
in Book Sketch Irish Migration to S.C.  
as having land bordering other names  
given. His land is on Broad River  
and near Little River.

one lists wife Sarah and four children  
James, Jacob + Joseph; David + Stephen
