I was born 30th day of Nov, 1878. I was married to him 25th day of Dec, 1898. My husband did not desert the service of the Confederate States nor of this State. My husband died on the 9th day of Feb, 1908. My income from all sources does not exceed \$ None. The valuation of all my property does not exceed \$ None. I am 71 years of age. I reside at Lawrence St, Fairfield County, S. C., and have lived there since the 10 day of April, 18 98.

I have been on the pension roll of South Carolina in Class C. H. H. I am not on the Pension roll of any other State, nor of the United States.
