abstract - Addley Hogan Gladden served as
Capt. in Mexican War. Brigadier
Gen. in Confederate War. Severely
wounded in the Battle of Shiloh on
April 6, 1862. Left arm amputated;
died either Apr. 12 or 14 at the
Headquarters of Gen. Beauregard
near Corinth, Miss. Buried in
Magnolia Cemetery, Mobile, Ala.

A. H. Gladden's brother - Daniel Webster Gladden
married Anna Elizabeth M^{rs} Meekin -
left Fairfield Co. to Arizona in Claiborne
Parish - then to Homer, La.

Dan'l W. also Capt. in Confederate War.
He & his wife buried in Old Homer
Cemetery. Their son, Francis
Isaiah Gladden married Emma
M^{rs} Neil Todd, dau. of Dr. John
(over)

William Todd and Anna Maria Harper.

From Mr. Martin's History of Fairfield Co.:

"Colonel A. H. Gladden, who went out as major of the Palmetto Regiment, became Colonel when Colonel P. M. Butler and Lieut-Colonel J. P. Dickinson were killed. Colonel Gladden was a brigadier general in the Confederate War, and was killed in Virginia. He was a native of Fairfield though he was practicing law in Columbia when he went to the Mexican War."
