Dear Jay,

Since writing you, I was sent proof that our Gladden relatives are children of Jesse Gladden. I'm enclosing a copy of Hall Equity Court records for Narciss Gladden Hall Montgomery. This was sent to me by Mrs. Alfred S. Evans who is a descendant of Silas Gladden. For some reason she did not list his children.

Do you remember the information about a Court Case: H. B. Montgomery vs. Silas Gladden, et al.? I wondered why the Hall children were not listed. Well, H. B. must be Greenberry why were some in Chester Co. and some in Fairfield. This is puzzling. Maybe Mrs. Evans can shed some light on that.

Ansel R. Gladden married Kizannah Hall, a dau. of Thomas Hall. Kizannah was not mentioned as Kiziah's dau. Also Narcissa (Sincy) was not named. Maybe both were dead and had no children. Or do estates have to go to that generation. I would think so. You noticed, I guess, that Amanda's husband was Jaylor. Now we have a Co. + state for Mary Jane. Maybe we can find out something there.

Under John Gladden, Nancy Jane's name was corrected from Price to Wright. This was done by her in a statement included in the papers. She also stated that her brother, John, died prior to her father, unmarried and intestate.
