I spoke with you this week about the papers you might have on the Gladden family. I am interested in the Jesse Gladden, William Gladden and John Gladden, all lived in Fairfield county, S.C.

I am looking for the proof of the maiden name for Jesse Gladden, born in 1753 in Fairfax, va, but moved to the Fairfield county, S.C. and married a lady named Ellen or Eleanor (LNU). We think her maiden name was Land, but have no real proof.

His children were: Littleton Gladden, born 1778, Lydia Sibby Gladden, born 1782, Sarah Gladden, born 1784, William Gladden, born 1790, Keziah Gladden, born 1792, Mary Gladden, born 1794, Silas Gladden, born 1795, James, James & John, twins, born 1796, Jesse, Jr., born 1797, and Dorcas born 1802. All of these children were born in Fairfield county, S.C.

If you have any old land transactions, or lawsuits, or any papers that might prove the maiden name of his wife, please send me the copies and I will send you the money, postage. My address is
