JESSE GLADDEN

There is not a household in the name of JOHN GLADDEN. Helen believes that John is is the household of Jesse Gladden. In this household there are two older males on being 45 & older, this male being Jesse, the head of the house. The other male is 26 to 45 which I believe to be JOHN GLADDEN. It is very possible that John's first wife shown with him on the 1800 census could have died. It is possible that all of his daughters were old enough to be married and gone from their father's house by 1810 census, and that would explain why there are none of John's children with him in 1810.

Helen has been able to obtain information on Wills of the Gladdens that are on the 1790 census which are:  
William Gladden married to Elizabeth who lived to be 107 years old.  
She had a will that named children and grandchildren.

JOHN GLADDEN--So far no will only Inventory of estate.

JESSE GLADDEN--Had a will that named his children.

By having the above two wills naming the children, then I had to use process of elimination to arrive at the children of JOHN GLADDEN which are as follows:

1. MIDDLETON GLADDEN
2. WILLIAM GLADDEN
3. LACY GLADDEN

I have not attempted to trace the females of John Gladden.

Born: Helen estimates Middleton to have been born about 1783 as he is shown with a wife in 1800 census. Please note his ages as follows as they are shown on census:

He had to be at least the age of 16 being he was married in 1800 census with a child. So I have estimated his birth year to be about 1783.

Married: According to the 1800 census listing a daughter, I would estimate that Middleton and Rebecca possibly married about 1799.

Born: about 1788/1789 (per 1850 and 1860 Census Fairfield Co.)

On the 1810 Census Fairfield County, there are two William Gladdens that appear as new heads of households. I believe that this above William Gladden is the one that appeared on Page 184, Line 50. The other William Gladden is in Chester County with a new wife evidently being they have no children. In 1850 there is a Mary Gladden born about 1784. I believe that this Mary is the wife of William in Chester County as the 1850 census states that Mary was born in Chester County.

I believe that William Gladden that appeared in Fairfield Co. in 1810 is the father of John L. Gladden. Mrs. James M. Gladden, Rt. 1 Box 46a, Casar, North Carolina 28020, wrote a book on the lineage of John L. Gladden who was born in 1800. The mother of John L. Gladden died 10 days after his birth so the father gave John L. Gladden to some folks and they moved him to North Carolina when he was young. On the 1810 census there is only one child that was born in 1800 and that child is under the head of household, William Gladden. On the 1820 census, this William does not appear as a head of a household. I believe that William is in Lacy's household age 26 to 45 (1775-1794) with no wife nor children.

Helen believes that William Gladden-1788/89 had two wives. As you can tell by the wife's age in 1810 does not match that of the wife in 1830. This above family of the 1830 census can be followed thru the census except in 1840 they are not in Fairfield

Helen has concluded that William Gladden married first about 1799. Then married Elizabeth about 1823.

The 1840 census is needed badly on this family. But after many hours of searching on microfilm and the indexes of the census, I have not been able to locate them.

The 1850 census, Fairfield County, South Carolina shows William & Elizabeth with a large family.

(In 1870, William and his wife, Mary are gone from Fairfield and Chester County. I believe that they may have died as their daughter Lydia J. Gladden is found in 1870 to be living with her uncle, Nicholas Gladden, at the age of 13. She may have married after this census as she does not appear on census of 1880 nor 1900 as a Gladden.)

George W. Gladden does not appear on the 1870 census as George in anyone's house. It is possible that on the 1900 census for Fairfield County in Dwelling 167, Page 68 that the head of the household might be George W. Gladden with wife and family. The first name cannot be read on this census due to census taker writing over the name. This particular household, I have not been able to place with the father of the Gladden.

I can make out the first Initial as G, the second could be an a or an e with maybe two letters in between with the last initial being an y.==Ge\_y or Ga--y. It is no where near the name of George but cannot help but wonder if it might be a nickname as so many used nicknames on census. Will list this family here:

George Gladden born 1827 according to 1850 census.

Being George was age 23 in 1850 and not appearing on census in anyone's house, it is possible that he moved away or went into Civil War. No further information found by me on George.

4th child of William Gladden (Son of John (I) Gladden)

Nancy Gladden

The 1850 census shows her to be age 21 being born 1829. On the 1860 census-Fairfield County, So. Car. Page 265, Line 33, Dwelling 1143--there is a James Gladden whose age is shown as either 58 or 24. I believe it to be 24.

I would like to add that I believe it possible that this James Gladden could be the son of William and Elizabeth Gladden. For in 1860 James is not in his father's household and I cannot locate James on the census of Fairfield and Chester County. Except for this James. If the age is 24 this would match with the James, son of William and Elizabeth. The Mary A. listed with James cannot be his sister, Mary B. because Mary B., daughter of William and Elizabeth is still in father's household. So I believe that this Mary A. listed in James' house is his wife. The Nancy that is listed in James' house would be the right age of 21 (1839) to be the daughter of William and Elizabeth who is not in her father's house in 1860.

I cannot locate this Silas Gladden in 1870, 1880, and 1900 census. There is a Silas Gladden on the 1880 census in Chester County with his sister, Eliza and nephew, Willie. This Silas is shown to be the age of 66 (1814) and Eliza, sister age 35 (1845) and nephew, Willie age 8 (1872). It shows Silas being born in South Carolina, his father being born in So. Car but the mother of Silas is shown to be born in Pa. This Silas that was on the 1880 census is not shown on the 1900 census of Fairfield And Chester counties.

Mrs. Regina Evans, 1150 Ivy Street, Chico, Calif. 94926 has done extensive work on the Gladdens of Fairfield and Chester County. She states that the Silas Gladden shown on the 1880 census is the son of Silas born 1784 who is the son of Jesse (I) born ca. 1750's and died in 1822.

I differ with this as follows: If Silas, born 1784, had a family of wife and children, why didn't he appear as a head of a household on the 1830, 1840 census. He appears alone in his own household in 1850.

I do agree that this older Silas (1784) is the son of Jesse (I). I believe that the Silas that appears on the 1880 census with his sister, Eliza may possibly be the son of William and Elizabeth with the census taker possibly making a mistake on Silas' age. It strikes me being very strange that the age difference between brother and sister would be 31 years. This is another reason that I believe that a mistake was made on Silas' age. With the nephew, Willie being born in 1872, this might explain why Silas and sister, Eliza did not appear on the 1870 census. Remember that the daughter of William and Elizabeth named Eliza appeared as Elizabeth with her brother Silas on the 1860 census, well this Eliza, sister of Silas on the 1880 census could very possibly be one of the same with only 5 years difference in the age shown on 1850 and 1860 census. I have this question though, why does Eliza and Willie carry the name of Gladden? If Eliza married, she would be carrying another surname. I re-read the census of 1880 to make sure that her name was Gladden and this is correct. It is Gladden and so is Willie's name. Either a divorce with her taking her maiden name or unmarried.

DECLARATION TO OBTAIN BOUNTY LAND

On the Eighteenth day of January A.D. One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty One personally appeared before me a Magistrate within and for the District and State aforesaid LACY GLADDEN aged Fifty-five years, a resident of the District and State aforesaid, who being duly sworn, according to law, declares that he is the identical LACY GLADDEN who was a private in the Company commanded by Captain William Nevitt in the Second Regiment of South Carolina Militia in the United States Service commanded by Colonel McWillie in the War with Great Britain declared by the United States on the eighteenth day of June, 1812, that he Volunteered at was drafted at Bells on or about the Second day of October A.D. 1814 for the term of Six months and continued in actual service in said War, for the term of Five months and was honorably discharged at Charleston on or about the Fifth day of March A.D. 1815. As will appear by the muster Rolls of said company. No Artificate of discharge was given. But Peace being made the company was discharged as a company.

He the aforesaid LACY GLADDEN makes the above declaration for the purpose of obtaining the bounty land, to which he may be entitled under the "Act granting bounty land to certain Officers and Soldiers, who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," passed September 28th, 1850.

Sworn to and subscribed before me, the day and year above written, and I hereby certify, that the said LACY GLADDEN is the identical man who rendered t the services aforesaid, and that he is of the age above stated.

She could not find one, nor any inventory but did find the following which gives me one step closer to Lacy (1796) Gladden being on the 1870 census in Fairfield County, South Car. It very definitely proves that Lacy (1796) Gladden was not the Lacy that died in the Civil War.

Eliza said that she looked and found Lacy on the 1860 census for Cleveland County, North Carolina, but could not locate him with his wife, Mary, whom he married on 21 May 1862. I told Eliza that I had this Lacy in 1870 Fairfield County, South Carolina Census.

Eliza agreed that she thought that I was right about Lacy going back to Fairfield County, So. Car. with him not appearing in court in September, 1869 in Cleveland County, North Carolina. Also with the 1870 census showing a Lacy Gladden being born 1800 Eliza Woodall and myself feel that my conclusion is correct.

Elza Woodall said that she found that the Gladdens in North Carolina were involved in a lot of murders.

I would like to explain how I arrived at John B. Gladden being the son of Lacy Gladden.

When I found that there was no Will on Lacy Gladden in Fairfield, Chester County South Carolina nor in Cleveland Co. North Carolina, then I had to begin the process of elimination by matching the children to the parents from 1900 census to the 1880 census. Then 1880 census to the 1870 etc. back to 1840. Here, in 1840 began the hours of matching, rematching, and ruling out the wrong children to the wrong parents. When finding out about the Wills of Elizabeth who was married to William (I) on the 1790 census; the Will of Jesse (I) on the 1790 census; and then the Will of Middleton, this helped tremendously. These Wills still did not name John B. Gladden. So the search continued. Finally, one night after working all day and up into that night, I said a prayer asking God to grant me wisdom to try to finish this work for Mr. Lumpkin to the best of my ability. I asked HIM to open my eyes to find a lead or clue to the parents to John B. Gladden's parents. The next day, after exhausting all trails--I decided that it looked like I was going to have to start all over again, and then all of a sudden, God answered my prayer. There was the answer right in front of me all of the time and I had worked with the Gladdens so much that I had completely overlooked the obvious. When this idea hit me, I was looking at the household of Lacy Gladden on the 1850 census. His household was taken by the census taker on the 7th of October 1850. Then I checked the household of John B. Gladden on the 1850 census and there the census taker had taken his household on 7th of October 1850. I, feeling that I was on the right track, then looked at John B.'s household on the 1860 census and found that his family had been taken by the census taker on the 26th of July 1860. By this time, the adrenaline was really flowing, so there I went to the 1870 census where I found that John B. and his wife and family except James Brown Gladden and his new wife "Nora" and their daughter, Jane were still in Chester County, So. Carolina. Where in the world John B. and family are in 1870 is still a question not answered by this compiler.

Now the reason I have gone into the above details of research in finding parents of John B. is as follows: Please notice that John B. Gladden was born in November, 1819 and having this proven by Bible Records and By Tombstone. But when each census was taken of his wife and children for 1850, 1860 and 1880 the census was taken several months before his birthday in November. Therefore this made him show to be born in 1820 and not 1819. This was why I never could match him to a head of the household in 1840. Armed with this new information I immediately went to 1840 census and found that the only male child being born in 1820 that had not been accounted for in my research was under Lacy. Other clues that made me feel that John B. was the son of Lacy was that on the 1850 census John B. was Dwelling 960 and Lacy was Dwelling 970. Also knowing that the older generations usually named their first born sons either by the father's side or the mother's father, this would work out to be correct, for as I have stated that I believe that Lacy is the son of John (I) and Lacy would have named John B. after his father.

JOHN B. GLADDEN Continued

I have no proof of Lacy Gladden and his wife Jane being the parents of John B. Gladden but I just know that it is right after over 300 hours of working constantly with the census of the Gladdens of Fairfield and Chester County, So.Car.

The only way we can prove this work of Lacy being the father of John B. Gladden is to locate a Will, which so far has not been located , OR to locate the settlement of Lacy's estate and there the children to be named, OR to locate the Family Bible of Lacy Gladden and Jane. I have found that many a time when looking for the Family Bible is to start tracing the females and if there is a Bible, it usually will be found in a families home that does not have the same surname that you are researching. In this case I would start with Susanna who appeared on the 1860 census with Lacy in Cleveland County, North Carolina. I would try to find when and who she married, then go to next census after her marriage, then onto other census up to 1900. Try to phone all in Cleveland Co., No. Carolina that has her same married surname. Then if that trail does not lead to a Bible, I would start with the next daughter in Lacy's household following same path.

JOHN B. GLADDEN was married about the last of 1839 or the first part of 1840 as their first child was born December, 1840.(Usually a child was born within the year of marriage.)

John B. Gladden was married to Mary Amanda Brown.

\*\*Helen's Note: I wrote Fairfield County Court in Winnsboro and found that they did not record marriages until 1911.\*\*

JOHN B. GLADDEN died 19 July 1897 per the Family Bible and Tombstone. He is buried in the cemetery at Ebenezer Methodist Church in Rossville, South Carolina in Chester County.

MARY AMANDA GLADDEN, wife of John B. Gladden is also buried in the cemetery at Ebenezer Methodist Church in Rossville, South Carolina. On her tombstone is printed Died 31 July 1919 and born December 1819. The year of her birth was questionable but the census of 1900 prove that the year of 1819 is correct.
