Sara Lynn Merwin, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Donald Merwin of San Francisco, formerly of Spring Valley, N.Y., was married yesterday to Ross Council Lumpkin, son of Capt. Pickett Lumpkin, U.S.N., retired, and Mrs. Lumpkin of San Antonio. Rabbi Roy Rosenberg and the Rev. Albert A. Ahlstrom, the Lutheran chaplain of Columbia University, performed the ceremony at St. Paul's Chapel at Columbia University.

The bride, a graphic designer, attended Bennington College and the Sorbonne in Paris and was graduated from Barnard College. Her father is a vice president of the National Center for Health Education in San Francisco.

Mr. Lumpkin is the manager and buyer at Benjamin Books in Rockefeller Center and is an instructor of English as a second language at the City University of New York. He was graduated from Rutgers University and received a master's degree from the University of Connecticut at Storrs. His previous marriage ended in divorce. His father was director of public affairs with the United States European Command, Armed Forces in Stuttgart, West Germany, and was formerly deputy chief of information of the Navy Department.
