Dear Nancy:

I'm sorry for the mix-up and the delay in getting back to you.

You wrote to me on the 23 Oct. 1984 and enclosed a check for \$100.00. Then, you wrote again on 4 Nov. 1984 and enclosed another check for \$100.00. I didn't think that you meant to send the second check, so I didn't deposit it. Please find it enclosed. Hope it didn't mess up your bank account. The holidays and other things just let the time slip by without any action on my part.

First, to review the latest information you sent.

You found the wills of Thomas Goodrum and William Porter in Maury Co., Tenn. You think Agnes Agnew Gladden Goodrum was dead by the time they went to Tennessee.

(His mother died at his birth, and he was given to his Aunt Patty.)

You believe the dates for William Gladden and for Sibbie Hollis Hall are incorrect. You think Sibbie is the same as the one in Fairfax Court records in 1753 bringing suit against Thomas Hall. Thomas Hall stole a coat from Benoni Hollis, and John Hall signed for him. James Hollis was also caught stealing the coat, and James Hollis, John Hollis, and William Gladin signed for him. [I haven't seen these papers.]

Russ Hall thinks Martha Gladden's father was not William and that Jesse and William Gladden were her brothers.

Summary of records which I have searched recently for you:

Estate of William Gladden. Apt. 49, pkg. 760. Fairfield Co., S. C. 30 April 1832. Distribution--Equal shares to:

Note that the Thomas Goodrum of the 1800 Fairfield Co., S. C. census is 45+. The Thomas Goodrum of the 1820 census is a younger man b. 1775-1794.

Scotch-Irish Migration, Jean Stephenson:

pp. 35, 43, 76, and 99.

John Agnew and David Montgomery came on the LORD DUNLACE in 1772.

Plat 6 Jan. 1773 ...laid out 300 acres to John Agnew... South fork of Wateree, bounded: Nicolas Thompson and vacant land.

David Montgomery...350 acres on branch of Wateree called Horse Br., bounded: John Agnew, Moses Hollis. Notation to see Fairfield Will Book 1, Bk. 5, p. 78.

Samuel Hall...150 acres on Peages Crk. of Little River... also 50 acres. 1773. He came on the PENNSYLVANIA FARMER.

John Hall...200 acres Enoree 1773. He came on the FREE MASON.

So, there we have it. John Agnew emigrated in 1772. Under the headright system, he had 4 persons in his family other than himself. John Hall and his family came into possession of this 300 acres.

I think an educated guess would be that Agnes Agnew was born about 1750. In 1772, she would not be included in John Agnew's headright as a dependent child in his family, as she would have been entitled to a grant in her own right (over age of 15). This would make her a contemporary of Elizabeth, William Gladden's wife. What was your original source on Agnes Agnew? *See Hall's notes undocumentated & letter of Dr. Nathaniel Barber Hall*

Note that Samuel S. Hall of Chester County, S. C. owned land near Mt. Olivet Church in Fairfield Co., S. C. *unable to establish him*

I searched for about an hour for Janie Revill's book at the Archives for Protestant Immigrants, but it was misplaced!

And, I wanted to look at Gladden and Hollis deeds, but with a time limitation, I couldn't do it all. I wish that I had kept the other check!

Nancy, I think our best bet at this point would be to read some of these equity cases. They may just lay the story in our lap; however, they could just as well not tell us too much. You never know until you look.

I'll be happy to continue if you desire, and I promise not to be so long. Since I already have the references, I can get right to it.

Watree Creek Baptist Church was known as Ralph Jones' Meeting House. *Never heard of this Church in Fairfield Co. Must be Camden*

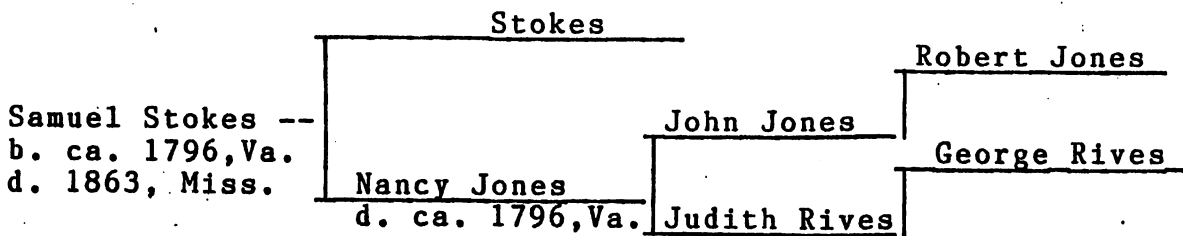
