

Indenture dated 28 Dec. 1769 between Robert Archer + William Gladden 100a. in Craven Co. on north fork of Rocky Creek l'd by vacant lands wit. Wm. Archer + Chas. Waters Recorded 17 May 1796

Index to Royal Grants - Wm. Gladden Craven Co. S.C. Broad River 100a 18 May 1773

Wm. Gladden (ca 1750-1793) md ca 1780 to Elizabeth (b? - d 1851 @ 109 yrs.). Elizabeth's will written 3 June 1842. Son William's children: Hannah, Sarah, John + Silas dau. Nancy Wilson w/o John Wilson, son John Gladden + Minor Gladden (1788-1869) md. Jane Tidwell (1791-1789). Elizabeth appointed executors Henry Gibson (who md Jesse's dau. Mary) + John McCulley. Wit to will: James Johnston, W. J. Gibson (Henry's son) + Frances McCulley.

Traditionally a William Gladden married Agnes Agnew - Rev's dau. Martha Gladden (1765-1842 who married John Hall (1765-1834) (Hall connection shows later with Jesse Hedden) Agnes Agnew Gladden is married. (over)

Goodrum - Had 2 daus. 1 married

who married Richard Didwell) the other

John Gladden, before John Buchanan J. P.

(Rev. War records show Elijah Hallis born 1763  
presumed son of Moses Sibella Hallis Hall  
traditionally sister of Moses had son  
John Hall born 1765. Nancy would have  
been born in that time frame 1763 - 177?)

- 9- Dorcas b. 22 Dec. 1802 d. 5 Apr. 1865 Cedar  
 Shoals Presby. cemetery md John Hall (bro.  
 to Thomas) b. 13 Dec. 1791 d. 17 July 1831. No  
 children. John's 1st wife died a few days after  
 birth of 4<sup>th</sup> child 1826. Dorcas Executor of  
 Wm. M<sup>o</sup> Russell's estate. Died prior  
 to Mar. 1838. John Hall's will returned  
 her property from John + William  
 Gladden.

The Nancy Jane you listed could be  
 confused with her daughter, Nancy Jane  
 Wright whose name was erroneously  
 reported as Nancy Price in Dorcas' estate.
