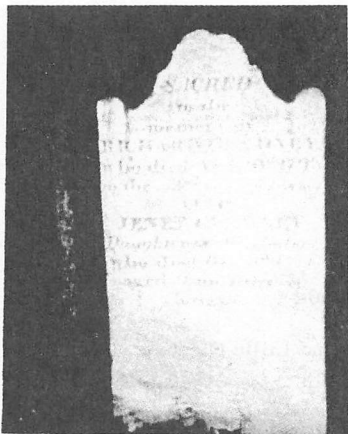


## GLADNEY CEMETERY RECORDS IN FAIRFIELD COUNTY, S.C.

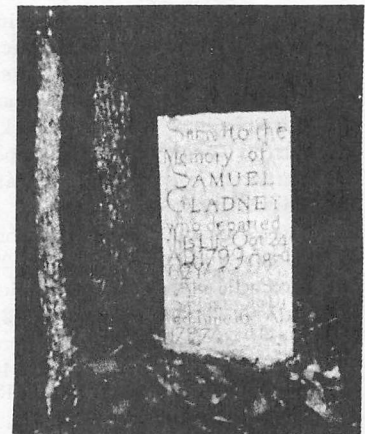

### GRAVES OF TWO REVOLUTIONARIES



**SAMUEL**

This cemetery was started in 1776 on one of the original grants of land to the Gladney Family. It is indicated by later documents that it was part of that granted to Joseph Gladney, the third of the brothers who were original immigrants. Today the property surrounding the graveyard is owned by Ed Stephenson. The cemetery is approached through a strip of woodland and a wide field of grass pasture land. It lies on a hill adjacent to the bottom land bordering the waters of Jackson's Creek. Today's highways are: West from Winnsboro on Rt. 34; Turn left on State Rd. 215 at Aiken's store; proceed to Jackson's Creek. The road to the Cemetery is approached through the second locked gate on the right of the road, going South after crossing Jackson's Creek. It is necessary to contact Mr. Stephenson for the key and for permission to use his roads.

Here five original immigrants of the Gladney Family, and two Revolutionary soldiers are buried. The virgin land of their grants received them on their arrival in South Carolina, and at the end of their lives sheltered them.

The following list was copied from the markers in the cemetery by Tom and Mildred Arnold, and Adah Odom Gilliam and Walton Gilliam. The monuments were photographed the following summer by Mr. and Mrs. Gilliam while the graveyard was overgrown with saplings and underbrush. As a result of this visit, an association for the preservation of the historic cemetery was formed with Mrs. Margaret McCann Holland (Amory, Miss.) as chairman. It has been fenced to prevent cattle from knocking over monuments, and is cleaned at intervals.
