

## THE OLD SAMUEL GLADNEY BIBLE

printed in Scotland in 1799  
was microfilmed and is on film at the  
LDS Libraries & Winnsboro Research Room  
NSDAR Bible Records dated 12 Feb 1971

The Bible was handed down to Richard & Mary Martha Bruce Gladney, then to their youngest Son Richard Jackson & Sarah M. Hardin Gladney.

Samuel is recorded as a Revolutionary Soldier during that war. He also recorded as having supplied live stock and wagons. His grave in the old Gladney cemetery has been denoted as such and the grave of Agnes McCreight Gladney as the wife of a Revolutionary Soldier, has been marked.

This Bible includes a DAR application of Annabelle Carroll, listing Samuel as a Revolutionary Soldier and lists all the children of Samuel and Agnes McCreight Gladney with as many dates as was know at that time.

The Family of Richard & Mary Martha Bruce Gladney is also listed with births, marriages and any deaths that were known at that time.

This Bible has been lost to the Gladney Family Association for many year. Cecil E. Gladney in 1997 told Bettye Bond that there was a Samuel Bible but he could not remember who brought it to a Winnsboro, SC reunion.

Searching through former reunion minutes, Bettye Bond found that this Bible was brought to a Gladney Reunion by Annabelle Carroll Heyward in July 1978 (this was so recorded in the minutes of the meeting by the secretary) The Bible had been recovered by Annabelle Carroll Heyward, the microfilm copy so stated this also.

Searching through Mrs. Arnold's correspondence a note was found to Annabelle Carroll Heyward concerning their family. Mrs. Heyward was contacted in 1998 and a visit to Columbia, SC was made by Gene & Bettye Bond, in hopes that the Bible could be located. After an extensive search through book shelves, Annabelle Heyward said she must have given it to one of the children. Further contact was attempted in 1998, however no one seems to have or know of the location of the Samuel Gladney Bible.

RICHARD McMILLING GLADNEY was born the 31st of Jan. 18 and not legible

RACHEL GLADNEY was born the 17th of Feb. 1818

WILLIAM McCREIGHT GLADNEY was born the 5th of April 1820

JANE GLADNEY was born the 17th of March 1822

MARTIE T. GLADNEY was born the 25th of Jan. 1824

These are two separate entries and one as Marthe T

MARTHA SADLER GLADNEY was born the 25th of Jan. 1824

RICHARD JACKSON GLADNEY was born the 31st of Jan. 1826 "Grandfather Jack".

RICHARD GLADNEY died the 8th of May 1843 "Grandpa Jack's father"

EDWARD B. GLADNEY died the 26th of Nov. 1843 "Grandpa Jack's uncle (uncle)

MANCY JANE GLADNEY was born the 28th day of May 1837

MARY ELIZABETH GLADNEY was born the 22nd day of Dec. 1840.

The death dates are on a separate page... The last two births are on back page of the deaths and at the end of The Book of Malachi.
