IN the name of God Amen:

I Elizabeth Glasier being of sound and disposing mind and memory but weak in body and calling to mind the uncertainty of life, and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to blefs me with do make and ordain this my last WILL in manner following VIZ. I Give unto my daughter Renthon Rabb one negro woman Linda to be disposed of at her decease as she pleases I also give unto my Said daughter Renthon Rabb one other negro boy Charles her life time, and at her decease Said Charles is to be given to my grand Son Joel Rabb. I also give unto my grandson William Ray Four hundred dollars. I also give unto my grandson Thomas Farborough One hundred dollars. Lastly I give unto my daughter Mary Free all my Wearing apparel together with whatever bedding and bed furniture I may be in pofession of at my decease not other appropriated the balance of my household and kitchen furniture to be Sold and the proceeds thereof with whatever money I may be in pofession of at my decease not other as appropriated also to be given unto my Said daug-ter Mary Free and I do constitute and ap- point John Rabb, and James W. Nelson Executors of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all other and former Wills and tes- taments by me made, in testimony whereof I have hereunte affixed my hand and Seal this 6<sup>th</sup> day of June 1838.
