IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN I John Glasier of the State of South Carolina Being weak in Body But of Disposing Mind and Memory Thanks be unto God, Calling into Mind the Mortality of my Body and Knowing that It is appointed For all Men Once to Die Do make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament that is to Say principally and First of all I give and Recommend my Soul into the Hand of Almighty God who gave it and my Body I Recommend To the Earth To be Buried in Decent Christian Form ~~-----~~ And as Touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to Bless me with I Give Devise and Dispose of in the Following Manner and Form, Vis First of all I Give unto My Beloved wife Elisabeth Glasier one Negroe Woman Named Linda and her Increase and Such of my Furniture as She Thinks proper to be possessed of and Money Enough to Make her portion Equal to any of my Childrens portion to be at her disposal if Conveyd away in her life time if not Conveyd away by will or otherwise at her decease the Same to be Equally Divided among Nathaniel Nelly John Rabb & Robert Rabb or their Lawfull Heire \* I Also give unto my Grand Son Glasier Rabb an Negroe Boy Named Tom a young Boy, To My Soninlaw John Free I give Five Hundred Dollars in Money Also To My Daughter Rebekah May Five hundred Dollars the Same to be Retained in the Hands of my Executors and given to her as they think most advantageous and in Case She Should Die Before She Receives Said Money the Same to be given to her The Children the Ballance of my Negroes Not already Bequeathed or willed To be Valued and Divided into three Letts as Equal in Value as possible and D<sup>ow</sup> for by <sup>my</sup> Sons in law Nathaniel Nelly John Rabb and Robert Rabb to whom I give and Bequeath the Same and if there Should be any Differences in the value of Said Letts of Negroes the person Drawing the Lett of greatest Value Shall pay to the other Legatee, or Legatees having a Share in this Lettery a Sum of Money Sufficient to make Each ones portion or Lett of Negroes the Same Value My Lands to be Sold on the Credit of one Two and Three years purchasers giving Note with

Twelve months with Note and Two Sufficient Securities I also Direct my Executors to pay all my Just Debts, and all Expenses Relative to the Execution of this my will and after I Also give unto Arthur Yarbrough Five Dollars in Money the Balance of my Estate or the Monies arising from Sales of my property above mentioned after the debts and Legacies are Satisfied to be Equally Divided Between Nathaniel Holly John Rabb and Robert Rabb and Last of all I Do Constitute and appoint Nathaniel Holly John Rabb and James W Nelson xx Executors of this my Last will and Testament and I do hereby utterly Disallow Revoke and Disannull all and Every other will Legacy Bequests and Executors by me in any wise made Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my Last Will and Testament in Witness Whereof I Have hereunto Set My Hand and Seal this 22<sup>d</sup> Day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty even and in year of Independence the Fiftieth
