A I. give and bequeath to my Executors herinafter named, the following slaves, Grace and her children John, Julia, Clara and Manning; in trust that they shall hold the said slaves and their future increase, for the Sole and separate use of my grand-daughter Lucy Clarke, for life, and at her death, upon trust, that they shall deliver the same to Such if sue as she may leave living at the time of her death, shere and where alike; provided that the if sue of a deceased child of the said Lucy Clarke, (if any such them be,) shall represent the Parent and take among them the share to which the parent, if alive, would be entitled. And if my said grand-daughter Lucy Clarke shall die, without leaving if sue living at the time of her death, then, I give and bequeath the said shaves and their future increase to her surviving brothers and Sisters.

- y I give and bequenth to my Executors, the following slaves, Molly, Mary and Hinds (child of Ceely) and their future increase, in trust for my grand daughter Elizabeth P Clarke, upon the same terms, conditions and limitations precisely, as are prescribed in the second clause hereof, in relation to the prevision made for her sister Imog.
- 8 I give and bequeath to my nephew Thomas Jones, a negro when named Amy and her daughter Sarah to him and his heim forever.
- 9 I will and direct that my servent Cudjoe be at liberty to choose his owner, and I give and bequeath said slave Cudjoe to such of my family or relatives, as he may select as such owner.
- 10 I give and bequeath the following claves, I copard and her child File, and Joe, to my grand daughter Lucy Toland, for life; and at her death I give and bequeath said claves and their future increase to such if sue as she may leave living at the time of her death.
- 11 I direct that within twelve months after my decease, my Executors raise out of my estate in such manner as they, in their discretion, deem most expedient, the sum of Sixteen thouseakd Pollars, (\$16.000.), and that said sum be invested in

and stocks as they shall approve, and that the income, of self fund, (commencing one year after my decease,) be paid over to my grand-daughter Lucy Toland upon her receipt, until she shall bear if sue living, who roupen I direct that the prinsimal be paid over and delivered to her. But if she should tie without leaving if sue living at the time of her death, the wid sum of Sixteen thousand dollars shall revert to my daughter Louisa Clarke, or if she be dead, to her surviving childres- It is expressly to be understood however, that this legsay, as well as that of the slaves in the next preceding clause hereof, are given to my grand-daughter incy Toland, exprefely, in lies of any claim she may have, or be supposed to have, to any other pert of my estate, or to any part of the estate devised and bequesthed to me nor life or otherwise by the will of my father Darling Jones, or to any part of the property real or personal, which my father Darling Jones may have comvered or given to me in his life time by dead or otherwise. I and in which it may hereafter be afterted and held that my interest is restricted to a life estate.); my intention being that in Consideration of the above bequests, she or those eleiming under or through her, are to respect and confirm the devices and legacied herein given to others, without questioning by power to dispose thereof: and if my said grand daughter may Toland or those claiming under or through her, should effect any claim on any protonce whatsoever, to any other part of my estate, or to any part of the estate devised to me by his will of my father Darling Jones for life or otherwise, or to may of the property real or personal, conveyed or given to me by my father Jones Darling Jones in his life time, by deed or otherwise, & whether for life or otherwise, then and in that event, I do hereby revoke and doclare void all legacies merein bequeathed to her and her if sue, and I give and bequenth the seme to my daughter Louisa Clarko, or, if she be dead, to her Surviving children.

14 And whereas my right to dispose of the slaves bequeathed to Thomas Jones, may hereafter be questioned by my daughter low-isa Clarke, or those claiming under or through her, now therefore I do declare, that in the event of his being thus deprived of said slaves, I revoke of the legacy given to my daughter, the sum or fifteen hundred dollars, which I there upon give to my nephew Thomas Joms.
