John L. Yongue had been appointed guardian, Alexander Calhoun moved to Talbot County, Georgia in January 1834, and wanted to take James Calhoun to Georgia.

Catherine Calhoun was the mother of Alexander Calhoun and James Calhoun.

**Frame 265 – 1834 #3 – Petition for Guardianship – Filed July 12, 1834**

Daniel Goin appointed guardian of Jane Goin-age 15 and Daniel Goin-age 14.

Daniel Goin was their uncle; their father was Robert Goin.

**Frame 269 – 1834 #4 – Bill for Guardianship – Filed July 6, 1834**

William Holmes appointed guardian of Sarah McKemie.

William McKemie-deceased

John B. Pickett guardian of Reuben Pickett, Elizabeth Pickett, Nancy Pickett-married an Allen, Sarah Pickett, Catherine Pickett, Jephtha Pickett and Kisanna Pickett, all children of Joptha and Ann Pickett.
