- 19, 418: William Gany, 200 acres on the north east side of Thomson's Creek in Craven County, 2 May 1770. Plat certified 22 Jan 1770.
- 19, 419: Henry Duke, 50 acres on Mudlick Branch adj. William Thomson, Henry Duke, Benjamin Moore, 2 May 1770. Plat certified 13 March 1770.
- 19, 420: William Hunter, 200 acres in Saint Johns Parish, Berkley County adj. estate of Chovin, 2 May 1770 .Plat certified 2 July 1765.
- 19, 421: Elias Horry, 82 acres in Craven County, Saint James Santee between Wambaw Creek and Santee River adj. Hon'ble Robert Pringle Esqr., John Dutarque, Thomas Carr, 2 May 1770. Plat certified 22 Feb 1770.
- 19, 422: Joseph Bradley, 100 acres in Craven County on a branch of Wateree called Cow Branch, 2 May 1770. Plat certified 3 April 1770.

- 19, 426: Reuben White, 150 acres in Craven County, the south side of Jeffreys Creek adj. William Werrill, William Tann, Anthony White, 2 May 1770. Plat certified 3 April 1770.

20, 2: Daniel Hoofman, 200 acres in Craven County on Dinnis's Fork of Bowers Mill Creek, 13 July 1770. Plat certified 5 Sept 1769.

20, 3: John Solomon & Stephen June, 100 acres in Craven County on the north side of Santee River in Prince Fredericks Parish adj. Willm Newman, John June Senr, Joseph Maybanks, 13 July 1770. Plat certified 5 June 1770.

20, 4: James Lyles, 150 acres in Craven County on the south west side of Broad & Tiger River, 13 July 1770. Plat certified 9 May 1770.

20, 5: Isaac Cook, 150 acres in Berkley County on the north side of Saludy on a small branch thereof known by the name of Beaver Dam Branch adj. Jonathan Gilbert, 13 July 1770. Plat certified 3 April 1770.

20, 6: Thomas Lantrip, 200 acres on the north side of Saludy River on a branch called Rayburns Creek adj. Thomas Owen, 13 July 1770. Plat certified 5 June 1770.

20, 7: Samuel Bell, 100 acres on Reedy Branch, waters of Savannah River adj. William Jones, 13 July 1770. Plat certified 20 March 1770.

20, 8: Edward Dickey, 200 acres in Craven County on the north east side of Black River on Home Branch adj. Robert Hume, 13 July 1770. Plat certified 8 June 1770.

20, 9: Robert Duke, 100 acres in Craven County on Twenty five Mile Creek adj. George Toy, Joseph Bradly, 13 July 1770. Plat certified 2 Jan 1770.
