Now in his pofession, also I give to George Lot and Brethareto Moses, my negro Boy Sem 12 years of ageI give to Enosh Lot, the Brother of Moses & George- my negre
Gairl Hannah & years of age and my negro bay George & years
of age, And in Gase either of my afforesaid Grand children
shall die before they came to the age of twenty one years and
unmarried, the negro or negroes so given to him or them so
dieing under the age of twentyone years and unmarried shall go
to and belong to the survivours or Survivour of them my said

lixthly I give to my son Enoch, one fourth part of the Richerdson tract of Land whereon I formerly lived Also my negro boys Charles & Peter, which negroes he is in pofsetsion of ince the year (1831) together with what he has had of me before the gift from me: previous to the gift of Charles and eter, (as per his receipt, in full) To him and his heirs forever----- Seventhly I give to my son John, the other fourth part of the Richardson tract of Land he and Enoch to Divide the one half of Said tract between them Equally, the other half is given to Rhoda Hedgepath . I also give to aforesaid John my two negro boys Maga & Robin. which negroes he has been posdesign of ever since (1821) together with what he has had of me before the gift of Magu & Robin) as per his receipt in full, to him and his heirs forever comes (Righthly) And whereas I have Six Small children. Tenth it is my will that the interest of the money arising

from the sale of Titleres and other personal property, the profits of my lands untill the year (1839) Shall be Disposed off by Executors for the maintenance of my wife and and for of my children their Education untill the year (1839) That as soon as my son Thomas shall come of age it is my will that my Executors then divide the whole of the money arising from the sale of my Estate. both real & personal be by them divided into Sevenequal Shears, that is one equal Shear or Seventh part to my wife "ary one Equal Aer Seventh part to my son Ashford, one equal Shear or Seventh part to my son Thomas, one equal Shear or Seventh part to my Daughter Minerva, one equal shear or Seventh part to my Daughter Mithense one equal Shear or seventh part to my Daughter Sirena one equal Shear or Seventh part to my Daughter Lucenda, Shear and Shear alike as tenants in Common, that if either of my aforesaid Six children ile pefore they attain the age of 81 years and unmarried it is my will that the Shear of the child so dising under age and unmarried Shall be equally divided between the Survivors or Survivor and of them my eforce sold Six children, Ashford, Thomas, Minerva Mithena Sirena and Lucinda, Shear & Shear alike-----

Minerva Mithema. Sirema and Lucenda, & for them and in their Behalf Give debloomer to my said executors full power and Authority over all that part of my Estate which
