

2014.032.6: Draft Last Will and Testament of David Hall, Chester County, South Carolina; reference son, William S. Hall (land on Turkey Branch of Rocky Creek); wife Sarah Jane Hall, daughter Susan Irene Hall, son Daniel Hall; 1871

State of South Carolina, Chester County

Know all men by these presents I, Daniel Hall of the State and county aforesaid, being of sound mind and desirous of settling my worldly business in order before my departure from this transitory state, do make in this my last will and testament the following dispositions, to take effect after my decease.

1<sup>st</sup> I will that my funeral expenses and just debuts be paid.

2<sup>nd</sup> I bequest to my Son, William S. Hall, Eight hundred (800) acres of land upon which he now resides lying on Turkey Branch, Waters of Rocky Creek, bounded on the east by lands of Bradshaw Lumpkin, John Hickey and others; on the north by ----Sibley and others; on the South by Joseph Aldrich, extending west so as to embrace the number of acres above specified.

3<sup>rd</sup> I bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah Jane Hall, and my Son Daniel Hall, and daughter Susan Irene Hall, the remainder of my estate, Real and Personal, of every kind, whether consisting of Land, Bank or Rail Road Stock, Money or Notes, Household or kitchen Furniture or otherwise, the same to be equally divided amongst them, so that each of these named in this paragraph may share alike.
